Results

Consensus Themes

- 1. Reimbursement should be significant enough to incentivize athletes to qualify and be willing to travel to elite level meets.
- 2. Reimbursement levels should be set at higher levels as the meet qualifying times become faster and the meet becomes more elite.
- 3. Reimbursement should be available for all participants at elite meets, including Futures/Open Water/Para travel meets, although relatively smaller reimbursements would be appropriate as compared to the more elite meets.
- 4. The overall travel budget and the reimbursement level for various meets should be designed to be fluid and flexible from year-to-year/season-to-season to account for the geographic location and projections of qualified athletes for the various meets.
 - a. For example, in a year in which National Championships is at OSU, the overall budget and reimbursement levels should be designed to be less in comparison to a National Championships conducted at Federal Way, Washington.
 - b. For example, as the Olympic quad cycle evolves, the projected qualifiers would be anticipated to be higher, so the Travel Committee should do forecasting of anticipated demand for travel reimbursements.
- 5. The allocation approach amongst different levels of elite meets should be fluid from season-to-season and allow for the Travel Committee to customize the allocation formula for determining reimbursements based upon the location and timing of the elite travel meets occuring in any particular year.

- B. Athlete Travel Reimbursement Levels for selected LSCs see <u>LSC Travel Budgets 2019.pdf</u> compiled by Chip Carrigan that illustrates various levels of budget relative to Year Round Athlete members in 2018
- C. **Travel Policy Comparisons** see <u>Travel policy comparisons.xlsx</u> attachment researched by David LLoyd comparing different LSC policies/approaches for calculating travel reimbursements.
- D. **Scenarios** see <u>OSI Travel Scenarios (3).xlsx</u> that contains simplified "what if" examples illustrating alternative mechanisms for allocating a capped budget amount amongst different levels of meets/swimmers. In general, the Ad Hoc Travel Committee preferred the Waterfall approach on the \$60K tab as it reimbursed the higher level meets at the highest level, but still allowed for a reimbursement to be made to the lower level meets. For the \$40K and \$20K tabs, the committee preferred the mechanism of the Allocation approach, but suggested the future Travel Committee should do further work around the amount to allocate amongst the various levels of meets/swimmers.

Recommended Next Steps

- 1. **Travel Committee** Mike Yeager to advise on formal steps necessary to establish an annual Travel Committee whose mission would include a) Proposing a capped/fixed annual budget for LC 2019 /SC 2020; and b) Designing flexible allocation mechanisms consistent with the recommendations of the Ad Hoc Travel Committee.
- 2. **Team Reimbursement Policy** Todd Billhimer to appoint an Ad Hoc Coach Committee to consider and deliver feedback.
- 3. **Fine Print of the Travel Policy** Erin Schwab and Joe Waller to incorporate comments from Ad Hoc Travel Committee and streamline/wordsmith the procedures.



Other Matters

- a. April 2019 cash inflows exceeded outflows. A combination of 1) collection of membership dues; and 2) meet revenue were the drivers of the excess inflows. Importantly, a significant catch-up is needed for Senior Travel reimbursements, for which the May 1st submission deadline has only just arrived. In April, the BOD approved an additional \$34K to be allocated from excess reserves to reimburse the higher than anticipated requests. Travel spend has far outpaced the prior year, and an Ad Hoc Travel Committee was formed after HOD to identify strategies for capping the go forward budget and allocating funds going forward. The Senior Travel policy will be updated for the Summer LC Championship meets, and the HOD members will be broadcasting such change in the summer policy to their respective constituents.
- b. Permanent office continues to pursue collection of aging membership dues receivable with a focus on the approximately \$39K of receivables that are in the 61+ day aging columns.
- c. Balance Sheet and Reserves: OSI continues to maintain a healthy balance sheet including sufficient reserves. Excess reserves are estimated at \$47K as of April 30, 2019. Note excess reserves will be further drawn down by the BOD authorization to utilize \$34K to reimburse excess travel requests.
- d. Quad Financial Forecasting: A Quad Financial Forecast is underway, and we intend to use this for planning in the FY 20 budget cycle that will kick off soon.
