FACILITY	The M.E. Lyons Branch YMCA facility is a Domed 6 lane 50 meter pool, configured for this meet as a 25 yard competition pool and 6 lane 25 yard warm up/warm down pool. Electronic timing is by Colorado Gen 7. There is a LED 6-lane scoreboard, spectator seating in bleachers on the pool deck. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with Rule 104.2.3C (4). The pool has a depth of approximately 12 feet at the start end of the pool and approximately 4 ½ feet at the turn end of the pool. The host will ensure the required course dimensions.

Free online concussion training is offered through the National Federation of State High School Association and Centers of Disease Control. There will be the required number of certified lifeguard(s) on duty at all times at this meet per Ohio Administrative Code 3701-31-04-E-4.

ELIGIBILITY	 Age classifications for events are: 8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & Over, and Senior. There are no minimum timestandards. Age for the meet is determined by the age the swimmer will be on November 8, 2025. All participants must be a member of the YMCA they represent for a minimum of 30 days prior to the start of the meet.
COMPETITION GUIDELINES & MEET FORMAT	 This meet will be contested in Short Course Yards (SCY). This meet will be a Timed Finals Meet Six (6) lanes will be used for all heats in all sessions. The meet referee reserves the right to combine events in accordance with USA Swimming Rules & Regulations. There will be no Clerk of Course. A timeline will be posted however, timelines are approximate and subject to changes.
ENTRY RULES -GENERAL	 Entries will be accepted on a first received basis. If your entries are limited, your coach will be notified. ABLY reserves the right to combine events and/or combine heats of opposite genders. ABLY reserves the right to require positive check - in for Friday night events.
ENTRY RULES - INDIVIDUAL EVENTS	 Swimmers may swim a maximum of three (3) Individual Events per day and a maximum of six (6) Individual Events for the meet. ABLY reserves the right to combine heats and/or events for time management purposes and may limit all events of 200 yards or longer.
ENTRY FEES	 Individual Events - \$5.00 per entry. All swimmers must pay a \$2.00 meet surcharge. This fee will remain in place for virtual participants. All entry fees must be paid to the meet host no later than 1 week after meet. (30 days late = 15% fee)

ENTRY PROCEDURES	Hy-tek Team Manager entry files will be accepted. Hy-tek entries should be sent via Email to Entry Chairperson Mark Lingo at mark@lingomfg.com by the ENTRY DEADLINE of Friday, October 29 th , 2025 at 5pm. The Hy-tek event file for Team Manager can be found on the League website. A print out of the Team Manager entries must be sent to the Entry Chairperson. All entries must include the Team Entry Summary Sheet and Team Certification Form. Teams should submit short course yard times with their entries. A check for all fees, made payable to "M.E. Lyons YMCA", must accompany your entry. If payment is made by inter-Y transfer, you must at least provide a copy of the transfer form with the entries. Checklist for Entries: 1. SWIMMERS WITH A DISABILITY	 ABLY welcomes swimmers with disabilities to participate in the meet. Entry Procedures: Enter the USA-S swimmers with a disability electronically or on the paper entry form. Provide the grouping the swimmer is identified under (P1, P2, P3) and any necessary accommodations. List in the email with the electronic entry (or on the paper entry) the swimmer's name, entry times, based on grouping (P1, P2, P3) strokes/distances and days/sessions. Preferred seeding is in the swimmer's age group entered event at the same distance with their equivalent non-conforming time to ensure seeding in the initial heats. See the Ohio Swimming Policy Book for grouping descriptions (P1, P2, P3).
MEMBERSHIP	All coaches must sign in for each session and present current YMCA credentials to be present on

	Coaches must be prepared to prove current YMCA credentials to be on deck in coaching capacity.
AWARDS RESULTS & SCORING	The Meet shall score 12 places using the traditional scoring method. Awards for 12 & under swimmers only.
	Meet Mobile will be available pending internet availability
WARM-UP AND SAFETY GUIDELINES	 The meet host will provide a complete schedule of warm-up procedures to include lane assignments and times, which must be adhered to by all participants. This information will be distributed in advance of the meet and published on the meet host website. Warm-ups will be monitored jointly by the Meet Director and Meet Referee (or their special designees).
	• Except during supervised racing starts, swimmers must enter the pool feet first in a cautious manner with one hand in contact with the pool deck.
	Ohio LSC Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warn-Up Procedures will be in effect for this meet.
	• Team representatives (a coach or designated volunteer) shall instruct their swimmers regarding safety guidelines and warm-up procedures as they apply to conduct at meets and practices.
	Coaches shall actively supervise their swimmers throughout the warm-up session at meets
	Coaches should maintain as much contact with their swimmers as possible, both verbal and visual, throughout the warm-up period.
	Warm-up procedures shall be enforced for anybreaks and/or any areas used for warm-up and warm-down during the competition.


