HOST FACILITY	The Powel Crosley Jr. YMCA Pool is configured as a 21 lane, 25-yard course with 20 lanes used for competition. Water depth at start is 7-11 feet (minimum 5 feet required) and the same at the turn end. Colorado electronic timing system will be used along with a digital Colorado scoreboard. The host will ensure the required course dimension. Warm-up lanes: Prior to prelim competition 16 lanes open for warmup. During Competition, 6 lanes open for Warmup/Warm down.

ELIGIBLE SWIMMERS (11 and over)	<u>YMCA Membership:</u> An athlete must be a YMCA member in good standing who holds an annual, full privilege membership at the YMCA he/she represents for a period of at least 30 days prior to the date of the competition. An athlete may have only represented that YMCA team in competition since September 1, 2025 excluding interscholastic competition. <u>Amateur Status:</u> An athlete may not have represented a college, university or other post-high school institution in any competition and may not have accepted pay or compensation for competing as a swimmer. <u>Unattached Athletes:</u> There is no unattached status in YMCA Swimming.

RULES	The meet will run under YMCA Rules that Govern Competitive Sports, Addendum to the YMCA Rules that Govern Competitive Sports, USA Technical Rules, and Southwest Ohio YMCA Swim League rules. • Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. • Deck changes are prohibited. • Operation of a drone or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, and/or spectators are present. • Use of cameras, cell phones or any other recording device is not permitted immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) during racing starts, competition and warm-ups. • Flash photography is not permitted at the start of any race

OHIO STATE LAWS THAT GOVERN THIS COMPETITION	CONCUSSION: Ohio's Return to Play Law (ORC 3313.539 and ORC 3707.511) requires that coaches and referees either (1) complete a free online training once every three (3) years in recognizing the symptoms of concussion or (2) hold a pupil-activity program permit from the Ohio State Board of Education. Free online concussion		

	training is offered through the National Federation of State High School Association and Centers of Disease Control. Training links can be found at www.swimohio.com under Safe Sport>Concussion. LIFEGUARDS: There will be the required number of certified lifeguard(s) on duty at all times at this meet per Ohio Administrative Code 3701-31-04-E-4. An AED is available.
TECHNICAL SUIT BAN	Per USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1F, 12 & Under athletes may not compete in Technical Suits at this meet. Please refer to the USA Swimming rulebook for definitions of a technical suit.
WAIVER/ RELEASE	By entering this meet, you are granting permission for the names of any or all of your team's swimmers to be published on the internet in the form of Psych Sheets, Meet Results, or any other documents associated with the running of this meet. All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the host club approved photographer(s) and videographers and to allow the right to use names and pictures before, during, or after the meet such as in public psych sheets, heat sheets, and results or featured on the host club website or social media or in public broadcast of the event via television or webcast.
