Championship Meet Information

Location	Please refer to the region map on page 7 to determine which CCS Regional Championship meet your Club is assigned. As per Section 2.4.2 of the College Club Swimming Governance Handbook, clubs may compete at a Regional Championship outside of their geographically assigned region but will compete as exhibition, are not permitted to swim in finals in prelims/final events, and are ineligible to score points. Such clubs who participate out of region will have their results uploaded to the CCS database and are eligible for Nationals qualification but are not eligible for top performance recognition according to the College Club Swimming Governance Handbook Section 2.5.3.

Sanctions	This meet is sanctioned by College Club Swimming. This championship meet is in the process of being officially recognized by U.S. Masters Swimming and USA Swimming. Times achieved at this event may be considered for USMS national records and Top Ten times for USMS members, and qualification for other USA Swimming Events. Swimmers wishing to have their times count for USMS/USA Swimming must provide their USMS ID# or USA Swimming ID. For USA Swimming specifically, in order for times to be eligible for entry into the SWIMS database, swimmers must 1) be an active member with USA Swimming and 2) have completed Athlete Protection Training no later than the individual athlete entry deadline. Individual swimmers must provide their USMS/USA Swimming IDs via Google Form by the athlete entry deadline.
Eligibility	Open to all current CCS swimmers who meet the eligibility requirements in accordance with the College Club Swimming Governance Handbook. There are no qualifying times for CCS Regional Championship meets. As per section 3.2.2, swimmers must be a current member of a CCS registered club and meet the College Club Swimming Amateurism and Eligibility Policy. As per section 2.4.1, swimmers must also be registered with CCS prior to the start of the Championship Meet in order to be eligible to participate.

Swimmers must be registered and entered in the meet prior to the entry deadline. Swimmers must also be over 18 years old prior to the start of the meet. For swimmers turning 18 years of age between the entry deadline and the start of the meet, please refer to the Under 18 Policy below for instructions on entering the meet and registering with CCS.

Under 18 Policy

Swimmers turning 18 between the meet entry deadline and the first day of the championship meet are eligible to compete in the 2025 CCS Regional Championship in accordance with the stipulations outlined in this section. This exception is only allowed for swimmers whose 18th birthday falls during the school year in which they intend to participate in CCS.

Eligible swimmers must:

- Be 18 years of age by the first day of their regional championship meet. **Swimmers turning 18 after the first day of the meet are NOT eligible to participate.**
- Register for CCS on/after their 18th birthday and by the first day of the championship meet. The president of the swimmer's club must submit the swimmer's CCS ID to ccs.regionals@gmail.com and collegeclub@usmastersswimming.org no later than 12pm (noon) ET on the first day of the meet.
- Submit their requested meet entries via [Google Form](#) by the entry deadline.

Swimmers with Disabilities

Swimmers with disabilities are eligible to compete in CCS Regional Championships. Prior to the meet, the swimmer and/or the coach/president of the swimmer's club must notify the Meet Referee in writing of the swimmer's disability so that, if needed, there is time for accommodations to be made. The Meet Referee may elect to have them swim the 50's during the able-body 100 events, 100's during the 200 events, and 200's during the 400/500 events, based on entry times.

Format

These championships will be conducted in the prelims/finals format. The 500 Freestyle, 400 Individual Medley, 1000 Freestyle, 200 Backstroke, 200 Butterfly, and 200 Breaststroke will be conducted as timed finals events in prelims. All relay events will be conducted as timed finals events in finals. All other individual events will be conducted as prelim/final events. During finals, Consolation (B final) heats will swim first followed by the Championship (A final) heats.

Seeding

The 500 Freestyle and 1000 Freestyle will be seeded fastest to slowest. All other preliminary and timed finals events will be seeded slowest to fastest.

Prelims Scratches

There is no penalty for scratches or no shows for preliminary events. This includes the pre-seeded timed finals events swam during either prelims or finals sessions.

**Finals
Scratch
Policy**

For all individual events that will be swum in a prelims/finals format, a scratch policy will be applicable. After results for prelim competition of an event are posted at the clerk of course, swimmers will have 30 minutes from posting to declare their intentions for finals.

Scratching will take place in two ways:

1. The swimmer or another club representative must print and sign their name, the date, and the event on a designated scratch sheet at the clerk of course table within 30 minutes of posting prelim results on behalf of the scratching swimmer. A swimmer may declare their intent to scratch depending on the swimmer's standing in future event(s) on the same day, but it is the responsibility of the swimmer to update the Clerk of Course of their intentions following the event(s) they specified.

2. If an entire club is not planning on returning to a finals session, the club president or another representative is responsible for notifying the Clerk of Course and signing off on a club scratch. Club scratches must be completed no later than the end of the day's prelim session. If a swimmer and/or the swimmer's club fails to scratch and appears in the finals line-up, whether or not the swimmer originally placed into finals, the swimmer is expected to compete at finals.

If the swimmer does not swim at finals, the swimmer's club will be charged \$10 per swimmer per event not swum. However, the swimmer(s) will still be able to compete in subsequent days.

Exceptions to this rule include injury and illness, in which the Meet Referee must be notified and will use discretion to accept proof thereof.

**Entry
Procedure**

All swimming entries should be submitted through CCS by way of Club Assistant's online entry system.

Once online entry opens, athletes will log in to the CCS website, select the respective Regional Championship on the home page, and enter events by entering a time for their events. Once submitted, their status will reflect "in meet roster" and the athlete is considered entered in the meet. Athletes may alter events at any time until the athlete entry deadline. Please note that "no time" (NT) entries will not be accepted.

At the close of the athlete entry period, the Presidents Confirmation period will open. During this time Presidents may modify any individual athlete entries and they must enter relays and submit payment information. Once the President Confirmation Period closes, entries are considered final and no late changes or submissions will be accepted.

Please note that for the Western Regionals Meet, a 1000 athlete entry cap will be in place. The details regarding the cap and the pre-registration process can be found on page 13. The other three regional championship meets will have no cap.

Entry Limits	Swimmers will be limited to 4 individual events and may enter all 4 relay events. Clubs may only enter a maximum of two relay teams (A and B) per relay event.
Entry Fees	The athlete entry fee for each championship site is \$35 per athlete.
Deck Entries	Deck entries are not accepted. Entries must be correctly submitted per the procedures listed above by the entry deadline.
Club Absence Policy	In the case that a club which has submitted entries is no longer able to attend due to extenuating circumstances, the club is still responsible for paying 100% of their meet fees incurred upon entry. No exceptions will be made.
Scoring & Awards	• Only “A” relays are eligible to score. • For Prelims/Finals events, points are determined solely on the basis of their respective (A and B) finals. • Medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in each individual and relay event. • Team awards will be given to the top three finishers in the Women's, Men's, and Combined Team categories. • Teams competing outside of their assigned region will compete as exhibition and are not eligible to score points.
Rules	The 2025 CCS Regional Championship meets will follow U.S. Masters Swimming rules for starts, strokes, turns, relays, and disqualifications. USA Swimming/U.S. Masters Swimming certified officials will be onsite to ensure compliance. However, since the meet is jointly sanctioned by USA Swimming, anything that warrants a disqualification under USA Swimming rules but not USMS rules will be noted and will only impact times entered into the SWIMS database. • Swimwear for Competition ○ Swimwear shall include only a swimsuit, no more than two caps, goggles, and a nose clip and/or ear plugs if desired. ○ Only swimsuits complying with World Aquatics swimsuit specifications may be worn. Suits with tie-backs or other fasteners are NOT permitted for competition. ○ Medical tape on the body is not permitted unless approved by the meet referee. K-tape on shoulders, elbows, or knees is never permitted. ○ Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits (except for drag suits) other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. Deck changes are prohibited. ○ Violation of any of these rules may result in disqualification. Exceptions may apply for extenuating circumstances at the discretion of the meet referee.

- Protests
 - Protests regarding disqualifications or recorded times shall be submitted to the meet referee within 30 minutes of the event. Protests regarding the conduct of the meet shall be submitted in writing to the designated meet official onsite. If the protest is with the referee, a formal complaint must be sent to collegeclub@usmastersswimming.org within 5 days of the event.

**Deck
Access**

This meet will operate with a closed pool deck. This means only swimmers, coaches, officials, and assigned meet volunteers will be allowed inside the designated competition course for any given session. Spectators shall remain in assigned viewing areas in accordance with facility guidelines.

**Camera
Zones**

The use of cameras, including cellphone cameras and/or other recording devices, is prohibited behind the starting platforms during the start of races, including relay starts.

The use of audio or visual recording devices, including cellphone cameras, is prohibited in changing areas, restrooms, and locker rooms.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present. USMS credentialed media personnel may be exempted from these restrictions. Any individual in violation of these restrictions may be barred from the venue by the meet referee or meet director.

About the Facility Dedicated in 2005, the Bill and Mae McCorkle Aquatic Pavilion consists of the Mike Peppe Natatorium and the Ron O'Brien Diving Well. The pavilion features seating for 1,500 and a 50-meter by 10 lanes competition pool, with two movable bulkheads so that two 25- yard pools can be set up. The competition courses have been certified by US Masters Swimming and USA Swimming in accordance with USA Swimming 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming and Ohio Swimming, Inc.

Competition Pool: Two ten-lane 25-yard pools will be used for competition. The water depth of the south competition pool is 9 ½ feet at start end and 10 ½ feet at the turn end. The water depth of the north competition pool is 7 feet at the start end and 10 ½ feet at the turn end. The lanes are 8.1 feet wide. The facility utilizes a Colorado timing system and two video scoreboards.

Warm-up Pools: One eight-lane 25-meter diving well, with a depth of 14 to 17 feet.

Seating: Spectator bleachers on both the west and east sides of the facility.

About the Facility	Dedicated in 2008, the Morcom Aquatics Center features a 50-meter by 25-yard competition pool (formerly used at the 2005 FINA World Championships) with two movable bulkheads, allowing for multiple course configurations including up to 30 practice lanes. The center also includes a separate diving well that can be used for warmups. The competition courses have been certified in accordance with USA Swimming 104.2.2C(4), with copies of such certification on file with USA Swimming and Florida Swimming. Competition Pool: Outdoor pool with two eight lane competition courses with a minimum depth of eight feet throughout. The pool is equipped with nonturbulent competitor lane lines, Kiefer starting blocks with adjustable track start, and Colorado backstroke wedges. A fully automatic Omega timing system will be utilized with results displayed on a viviLED video scoreboard. Warm-up Pools: A minimum of eight 25-yard warm up lanes will be available throughout the meet in the diving well located adjacent to the competition pool. Seating: Spectator bleachers on the side of the facility closest to the diving well.

About the Facility Completely renovated in 2018, the Marguerite Aquatics Complex is an elite swimming facility and home to the Mission Viejo Nadadores swim club. It has hosted events including the TYR Pro Swim Series and USMS National Championships. The facility centers on a 50-meter x 25-yard competition pool. The lanes, gutters, and anti-wave racing dividers are designed to smooth water during competitions. The pool depth measurement at the south end is 2 meters and at the north end is 3 ½ meters. The length of the competition course without a bulkhead complies and is on file with USMS per articles 105.1.7 and 106.2.1.

Competition Pool: One ten-lane 25-yard competition pool will be utilized for competition. The facility utilizes an Omega timing system with a video scoreboard.

Warm-up Pools: One ten-lane 25-yard competition pool (on the other side of the bulkhead from the competition course) will be used as continuous warmup during all sessions. The complex also includes an eight lane 25-meter by 25-yard diving well.

Seating: Spectator stands for 2000 located on the west side of the facility.

The 2025 CCS Western Regional Championship Meet has an athlete entry cap of 1000 swimmers. Teams who wish to participate must fill out the Tentative Attendance/Pre-Registration Form, which will become available on Wednesday, October 1st at 12pm ET and will be linked on the College Club Swimming website (collegeclubswimming.com) and sent in the CCS Presidents' Discord. On this form, clubs must provide an estimated number of swimmers to reserve space for their club.

The deadline to pre-register is Friday, October 10th at 11:59pm ET or until the 1000 swimmer cap is reached, whichever comes first. Clubs will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. The pre-registration process will be monitored by the meet liaisons in order to ensure that clubs are only reserving space for members of their club who plan to compete at the championship meet.

Athletes from pre-registered clubs may begin to register for the meet on Monday, October 12th at 12pm ET via the CCS Portal. Registration will only be open to athletes from clubs who have pre-registered and reserved space in the meet. Entries for each club will be capped at the amount that they previously reserved space for. Athletes from pre-registered clubs must register themselves for the meet no later than Wednesday, October 22nd at 11:59pm ET.

If a club has more athletes signed up than are pre-registered, clubs will be contacted by the meet liaisons and will be asked to reduce the number of athletes registered to match the space reserved during the pre-registration period. If the cap has not been reached, clubs that would like to bring more athletes than space was reserved for may reach out to the meet liaisons to request additional space on a first-come, first-served basis.

If any space remains by the October 22nd deadline, and if the timeline allows for additional athletes to be able to be added to the meet, registration may open to all athletes from all clubs on Thursday, October 23rd at 12pm ET, regardless of pre-registration status. If this is the case, an announcement will be sent out, and registration will close on Wednesday, October 29th at 11:59pm ET or when the available space has been filled, whichever comes first. If no space remains by the October 22nd deadline, then registration will remain closed.

Note on the Order of Events Since the Western Regional Championship Meet will be using one competition course, the 500 Freestyle and 1000 Freestyle events will be swum fastest to slowest, alternating heats by gender. This means that the fastest women's heat will go first, followed by the fastest men's heat, and so on. About the Facility Opened in December 2017, the state-of-the-art Liberty University Natatorium features seating for 1,400 and a 50-meter by 9 lanes competition pool, with a movable bulkhead so that two 25-yard pools can be set up. The competition courses have been certified by US Masters Swimming and USA Swimming in accordance with USA Swimming 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming and Virginia Swimming.

Competition Pool: Two 25-yard pools will be used for competition, one nine-lane pool and one eleven-lane pool which will have the end lanes at either side of the course as open. The water depth of both pools is continuously 7 ft and both courses feature overflow gutters with non-turbulent lane markers. The facility utilizes Paddock starting blocks with track plates, Colorado backstroke wedges, and an Omega/Swiss timing system. Two video boards allow for two simultaneous course displays plus the ability to scroll preliminary results.

Warm-up Pools: One 25-yard eight-lane diving well, with a depth of 17 feet.

Seating: Spectator wrap-around three-sided seating for 1,400.
