MEET FORMAT:	<ul> <li>This is an Invitational Meet: This meet is a closed (YMCA teams only) invitational meet open to all YMCA registered swim teams within the Southwest Ohio YMCA Swim League. The competition will be hosted at the Blue Ash YMCA.</li> <li>LIMITS – This will be an in-person meet. This will be limited based on space. We will be limiting our entries to 250 swimmers per session.</li> </ul>
Fees & Entry Limits	<ul> <li>Swimmers may swim a maximum of 3 individual events per day, 6 events for the weekend. 8 and Under swimmers can swim 4 events on Friday Evening ONLY and 3 Events on Saturday ONLY.</li> <li>\$6.00 per individual event.</li> <li>\$6.00 per swimmer surcharge - electronic heat sheets/AWARDS Teddy Bears Supply</li> <li>\$20.00 per relay event.</li> </ul>
TEAM ELIGIBILITY	This meet is a closed (YMCA teams only) invitational meet open to all YMCA registered swim teams within the Southwest Ohio YMCA Swim League.
Eligibility	<ul> <li>All contestants must be a member in good standing of a YMCA.</li> <li>USA Swimming members must be registered for the current season for times to be entered into the National Database. Registrations will not be accepted at the meet.</li> <li>All adult athletes must hold the current Athlete Protection Training certification.</li> <li>Age on the first day of the meet will determine age for the entire meet.</li> </ul>

Disability Swimmers:	<ul> <li>Ohio Swimming/YMCA Swimming welcomes swimmers with a disability.</li> <li>Entry Procedures:</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Entry Procedures.</li> <li>1. Enter the USA-S swimmers with a disability electronically or on the paper entry form.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>2. Provide the grouping the swimmer is identified under (P1, P2, P3) and any necessary accommodations.</li> </ul>
	3. List in the email with the electronic entry (or on the paper entry) the swimmer's name, entry times, based on grouping (P1, P2, P3)strokes/distances and days/sessions
	<ul> <li>Preferred seeding is in the swimmer's age group entered event at the same distance with their equivalent non-conforming time to ensure seeding in the initial heats.</li> </ul>

	• The meet host will provide a complete schedule of warm-up procedures to include lane assignments and times, which must be adhered to by all participants. This information will be distributed in advance of the meet.
Warm Up & Safety	<ul> <li>Warm-ups will be monitored jointly by the Meet Director and Meet Referee (or their special designees).</li> </ul>
Guidelines	<ul> <li>Except during supervised racing starts, swimmers must enter the pool feet first in a cautious manner with one hand in contact with the pool deck.</li> </ul>

	• YMCA Membership: An athlete must be a YMCA member in good standing who holds an annual, full privilege membership at the YMCA he/she represents for a period of at least 30 days prior to the date of the competition. An athlete may have only represented that YMCA team in competition since September 1, 2025 excluding interscholastic competition.
ELIGIBLE SWIMMERS	<ul> <li><u>Amateur Status</u>: An athlete may not have represented a college, university or other post-high school institution in any competition and may not have accepted pay or compensation for competing as a swimmer.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Unattached Athletes: There is no unattached status in YMCA Swimming.</li> <li>Age: An athlete must be at least five (5) years of age, and not older than twenty-one (21) years of age on the first day meet. High school post-graduate swimmers are eligible as long as they have not represented a post-high school institution.</li> </ul>

USA SWIMMING RULES	<ul> <li>At a USA approved competitive event, all USA Swimming athletes must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach. Arrangements for coach supervision must be made in advance of the meet.</li> <li>Any USA swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the Page 2 Organization Regulations/Waivers backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> <li>The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.</li> <li>Use of cameras, cell phones or any other recording device is not permitted immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) during race starts, competition and warm-ups. Please refer to the Safe Sport section of the Ohio Swimming, Inc. policies and procedures for further information regarding the use of visual recording devices.</li> <li>Deck changes are prohibited.</li> <li>Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</li> <li>Flash photography is not permitted at the start of any race.</li> <li>All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.</li> </ul>
Awards	<ul> <li>For all 12 and Under Swimmers- custom TEDDY BEAR medals will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, place finishers in events, and to 1<sup>st</sup> place relays. Ribbons will be awarded to the 4<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> place finishers in the individual events, and 2<sup>nd</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> in relays</li> <li>All 8 and under swimmers on Friday evening will receive a small stuffed teddy Bear.</li> <li>Heat winner's awards- heat winners for all heats, including 13 and over swimmers, will be awarded a small stuff teddy bear.</li> <li>RECOGNITIONS: A custom plaque will be awarded to the HIGH POINT swimmer in each following age group:</li> <li>FRIDAY NIGHT ONLY – 7-8 AGE GROUP WINNER WILL BE ANNOUNCED</li> <li>8 &amp; Under events on Saturday PM will NOT count towards high point awards.</li> <li>NO high point awards for 13 &amp; over or 6 &amp; under</li> <li>Saturday and Sunday – 9-10, 11-12 high point will be announced Sunday</li> <li>Relay events will not count towards high point awards.</li> <li>Swimmers can earn up to five teddy bears. After earning 5 bears then they will be given candy as a heat winner. This follows the YMCA honor code.</li> </ul>

Ohio State Laws that are applicable to Ohio Swimming sanctioned events	<ul> <li>Ohio's Return to Play Law (ORC 3313.539 and ORC 3707/511) requires that coaches and referees either (1) complete a free online training once every three (3) years in recognizing the symptoms of concussion or (2) hold a pupil-activity program permit from the Ohio State Board of Education. Free online concussion training is offered through the National Federation of State High School Association and Centers of Disease Control. Training links can be found at www.swimohio.com under Safe Sport&gt;Concussion.</li> <li>There will always be the required number of certified lifeguard(s) on duty at this meet per Ohio Administrative Code 3701-31-04-E-4.</li> </ul>
WAIVER/ RELEASE	<ul> <li>By entering this meet, you are granting permission for the names of any or all of your team's swimmers to be published on the internet in the form of Psych Sheets, Meet Results, or any other documents associated with the running of this meet.</li> <li>All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the host club approved photographer(s) and videographers and to allow the right to use names and pictures before, during, or after the meet such as in public psych sheets, heat sheets, and results or featured on the host club or OSI website or social media or in public broadcast of the event via television or webcast.
