Entries: Hytek Team Manager will be used for all entries. Be sure to use the entry file specified for the ECC Championships. **2026 ECC Swim & Dive Championship**. All times must be completed to the hundredth of a second.

Each swimmer is limited to two individual events and two relays or one individual event and three relays. Each school is limited to four individuals per event.

Diving counts as one event.

Each school may enter two relays per event. Coaches need to submit their entries for their relays as part of their Hytek file. Relay name changes can be made at the computer desk before the relay swims.

A scratch sheet will be available at the computer table and all scratches should be made before the coaches meeting starts. **NO CHANGES WILL BE ALLOWED AT THE MEET** (*Besides substitutions because of illness*). You may NOT take someone out of an event and replace them with another.

Diving: All information has been sent directly from Lisa W at West Clermont. Please follow those instructions for Diving registration.

Deadlines: Entries must be emailed to **Mark Johnson, ECC Swim Meet Manager** at mark.johnson256@gmail.com no later than 5:00 pm on Tuesday, January 20th

Once all entries have been submitted, a psych sheet will be created and posted to swimmeet.com. You will also receive an email with your entry lists, warm-up schedule, timeline, and psyche sheet on/before **Thursday, January 22nd, 2026**

Scoring: Each event will be scored through twelve (12) places. The scoring system is as follows: 16, 13, 12, 11, 10, 9, 7, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. For relays, the point total for each place will double.

Awards: The top 3 athletes/relay teams in each event will receive an ECC medal as well as be recognized the day of the event on the podium. This will happen at the end of each event. Turpin will provide a Meet Worker to hand out the medals.

Links to vote:

Will be distributed by ECC Commissioner, Ray Spicher. After the conclusion of the meet, Head Coaches will nominate and vote on Female & Male Swimmer of the Meet as well as ECC Coaches of the Year. Plaques will be sent to those swimmers by the ECC.

Competition: We will be utilizing 9 lanes for competition and will have 11 lanes of continuous Warmup / warm down in separate pools. Swimmers who are registered members in good standing at the time of the swim that are entered with their full name, DOB and USAS ID in the school's entry file will have their times submitted to the USA Swimming SWIMS database. **Observation number OH-26SC-144OB**

Seeding: This meet is a timed final format and all seeding will be Championship Seeding.

Notes: Live results of swimming events will be posted to Meet Mobile.
