All entries must be submitted electronically via email using Hy-Tek Team Manager software. Follow the entry instructions posted on the OHSAA website. An event file is also posted on the OHSAA website.

Psych Sheets will not be posted until Tuesday, February 10, 2026 at 6:00pm.

Entry times must be indicated for the events. No changes in entry times can be made after the entry deadline.

The new high school building is done and the older building has been removed so our entry procedures have changed again.

- Bus Drop-off and Parking Information: our parking and traffic flow to the high school has been reconfigured. I am attaching a map for your convenience and would ask that you please send this along to your transportation department and families. Also please note that the entrance for the natatorium will be through the original pool lobby doors. It can be accessed from the new high school front parking lot or the new back parking lot (walk between the new school and the pool/wrestling complex from either direction to the pool lobby doors).
- We currently do not have any visible access to the new building for team areas, so we will be utilizing 6 of the upstairs classrooms and the wrestling room to house teams. Teams will be assigned to those rooms and the wrestling room by the sectional meet manager. No Bags on deck.
- ALL TEAMS: If you have athletes on your team who did not make your sectional squad, please have them stay home. This site has the most athletes with very little deck space and no extra spectator seating. Questions regarding this should be directed to Coach Moran.
- Relay cards will NOT be used. Coaches will need to turn in their relay sheets before the start of the meet. Coaches may change their order or personnel at any time prior to the

start of the event. Please let the timing booth know if you made any changes to the relays.

- Locker rooms should be used to enter and to exit the pool area. No swimmers will be allowed down/up the ramp area and no swimmers will be allowed in the spectator stands.
- Swimmers/Coaches are not allowed to walk on the north deck in front of the spectator seating during competition.
- No athletes will be allowed to sit on the scoreboard side bleachers in the competition pool.
- With the new scoreboard being lower, no one will be allowed to sit under the scoreboard. It is roped off.
- Individual teams are responsible to pick up debris in their area.
- There is a new hospitality room for coaches and officials in the HVAC room upstairs behind diving boards. (Turn Left)
- No swimmers will be allowed to use the stairs behind the blocks to go up to their rooms, they must use the locker-rooms to enter and exit.
- The warm-up pool will be open throughout the meet. One hand on deck to enter the pool will be enforced and there is NO diving.
- NO Rub-down tables are permitted
- No food on deck.
- Per OHSA Rules, NO SHAVING at the meet facility. Any athlete found to be in violation will be ejected from the meet.
- Shirt sales will be online. On-site, is TBD.
- This meet has been sanctioned as a USA Swimming Observed meet (OH-26SC-149OB). Coaches must include the swimmer's full name, USA ID and DOB in the entry file if they wish to have the athlete's times loaded into the SWIMS database. The athlete must be a USA Swimming member in good standing before the day of the meet.
