	 Any USA Swimming member athlete entered in the meet <u>must</u> be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
	 Use of cameras, cell phones, or any other recording device is not permitted immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) during race starts, competition and warm-ups. Please refer to the Safe Sport section of the Ohio Swimming, Inc. policies and procedures for further information regarding the use of visual recording devices.
	Deck changes are prohibited.

Safe Sport 360	 The USA Swimming Safe Sport program is USA Swimming's comprehensive abuse prevention program dedicated to creating a healthy and positive environment free from abuse for all its members. Components of the program include, but are not limited to, providing education and training, enforcing policies (such as the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy), rules and best practice guidelines, promoting healthy boundaries and mandatory reporting of violations.

USA Swimming Membership verification deadline is 12 PM EST two (2) business days prior to the first day of the meet (1/25/2026) for times to be considered for this APPROVED meet status. Unverified USA Swimming swimmers' times will not be considered for SWIMS. • All adult athletes must hold current Athlete Protection Training certification. • Age on the first day of the meet will determine the age for the entire meet. Follow requirements for YMCA Sanctioning for participating athletes following the "The Rules that Govern YMCA Competitive Sports & the Addendum" **All YMCA Coaches:** Are required to maintain current certifications in Basic Life Support (Professional Rescuer CPR), First Aid, Safety Training for Swim Coaches, Child/Athlete Protection Training and Principles of YMCA Competitive Swimming and Diving. These are verified at the meet. Have completed the online YMCA coach registration for the current season. Athletes: Age 18 and older have completed Child/Athlete Protection Training within the past 12 months. Age 12 and under may not compete in Technical Suits, as defined in the USA Swimming Must have been full privilege members of the YMCA they represent for at least 30 days prior to the first day of the meet. Teams: All participating teams have completed the YMCA Team Registration for the current season. Disability Ohio Swimming welcomes swimmers with a disability. Swimmers: • Entry Procedures: 1. Enter the USA-S swimmers with a disability electronically or on the paper entry 2. Provide the grouping the swimmer is identified under (P1, P2, P3) and any necessary accommodations. 3. List in the email with the electronic entry (or on the paper entry) the swimmer's name, entry times, based on grouping (P1, P2, P3) strokes/distances and days/sessions. Deck Entries	Deck entries will be accepted at this meet for athletes verified by the published deadline in this meet information. Swimmer must still follow the FOUR individual per day meet rule. Deck entries will be entered in empty lanes only.
	DECK ENTRIES \$7 per individual event; \$5 surcharge if swimmer not currently entered in meet
	Deck Entries must be submitted 45 minutes before the start of the meet session

	Heat winner ribbons will be distributed.
