Exit will be thru the same door.</li> <li>Smoking is not allowed on the campus of Wauseon High School.</li> <li>All swimmers are to stay in the areas of the Wauseon High School designated for the swim meet. Other area of the High School will be closed during the meet.</li> <li>Any food or beverages brought into the pool should be prepackaged or well-sealed in a lunch box</li> <li>Only swimmers, coaches, and meet personnel are to be on the deck.</li> </ol>

Organization Regulations/Waivers		
USA Swimming	<ul> <li>At a sanctioned competitive event, all USA Swimming athletes must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach. Arrangements for coach supervision must be made in advance of the meet.</li> </ul>	
Rules	<ul> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet <u>must</u> be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Use of cameras, cell phones or any other recording device is not permitted immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) during race starts, competition and warm-ups. Please refer to the Safe Sport section of the Ohio Swimming, Inc. policies and procedures for further information regarding the use of visual recording devices.</li> </ul>	

• Deck changes are prohibited.

#### Organization Regulations/Waivers Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. • Flash photography is not permitted at the start of any race. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Per USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1F, 12 & Under athletes may not compete in Technical Suits at this meet. Please refer to the **Technical Suit** USA Swimming rulebook for definitions of a technical suit. Ban **Ohio State** Ohio's Return to Play Law (ORC 3313.539 and ORC 3707.511) requires that coaches and referees either (1) complete a Laws that are free online training once every three (3) years in recognizing the symptoms of concussion or (2) hold a pupil-activity applicable to program permit from the Ohio State Board of Education. Free online concussion training is offered through the National Ohio Federation of State High School Association and Centers of Disease Control. Training links can be found at **Swimming** www.swimohio.com under Safe Sport>Concussion. sanctioned There will be the required number of certified lifeguard(s) on duty at all times at this meet per Ohio Administrative Code events 3701-31-04-E-4. Safe Sport 360 The USA Swimming Safe Sport program is USA Swimming's comprehensive abuse prevention program dedicated to creating a healthy and positive environment free from abuse for all its members. Components of the program include, but are not limited to, providing education and training, enforcing policies (such as the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy), rules and best practice guidelines, promoting healthy boundaries and mandatory reporting of violations. The Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) prohibits Applicable Adults (as defined) from having one-on-one interactions with minor athletes which are not within an observable and interruptible distance from another adult. Applicable Adults are required to abide by this policy in full during this meet. (www.usaswimming.org/maapp) Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. Various state laws may also require reporting to law enforcement or to a designated child protection agency. All athletes aged 18 and older must complete Athlete Protection Training in order to be a USA Swimming registered member in good standing. Any athlete who turns 18 on or after the first day of the start of competition, who has not completed Athlete Protection Training by the first day of competition, will be prohibited from participating in the competition until such time as all membership requirements are completed. Times achieved by an athlete who turns age 18 on or after the first day of competition, who competes in this USA Swimming sanctioned event without completing this membership requirement, will NOT count for qualification or recognition. This includes participation as a member of a relay. Unverified swimmers will be scratched from the meet after that deadline. There will be no refunds for unverified swimmers scratched from the meet.</li> <li>All adult athletes must hold current Athlete Protection Training certification.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Age on the first day of the meet will determine age for the entire meet.</li> <li>NT will be accepted for any event.</li> </ul>	
	Some events may have "no faster than" standards

	List in the email with the electronic entry (or on the paper entry) the swimmer's name, entry times, based on grouping (P1, P2, P3) strokes/distances and days/sessions.			
	<ul> <li>Preferred seeding is in the swimmer's age group entered event at the same distance with their equivalent non-conforming</li> </ul>			
	time to ensure seeding in the initial heats.			
	See the Ohio Swimming Policy Book for Grouping descriptions (P1, P2, P3).			
Entry Limits	Swimmers may swim a maximum of 4 individual events per day.
