

Western Reserve Conference Swimming & Diving Championships at Mayfield High School & Cleveland State University January 2 & 3, 2026

SWIMMING

WHERE: The swim meet will be held at Busbey Natatorium at Cleveland State University

WHEN: Boys and Girls will swim on Saturday, January 3, 2026. They will swim together in one session.

TIMES: Saturday- warmups: 11:30 AM - 12:30 PM with the meet starting at 12:40 PM.

MEETING: There will not be a coach's meeting prior to the meet.

HOSPITALITY ROOM: Hospitality contains food and drinks for coaches, officials, and meet volunteers. The responsibility of this room rotates from year to year among WRC teams. **CHARDON** is responsible for 2026.

SCRATCHES:

- All scratches must be done immediately upon your arrival at the computer table and no later than one hour before the start of the session, including relay names.
- Swimmers need to notify timers of the relay order at the block.

FACILITIES:

- The pool is ten lanes, 25 yards long, numbered 1 to 10
- No swimmers are allowed on the diving board side of the pool except for one counter per lane during the 500 free
- Swimmers are not allowed in the area immediately behind the starting block area unless they are competing in the event in the water or the event on call. Please keep this area as clear as possible for the timers and officials
- Coaches and swimmers need to remain quiet at the start and keep the areas clear for the officials
- Only coaches, swimmers, meet workers, and officials should be on the deck. It will be up to coaches to monitor swimmers
- Wristbands must be worn by coaches to be permitted on deck and for admittance into hospitality
- Only volunteers wearing a deck pass will be permitted on deck during the meet
- The girl's and boy's locker rooms will be available for the girls and boys, respectively
- We are not responsible for personal belongings
- Coaches are responsible for seeing their team areas and locker rooms are left clean at the end of the meet
- NO glass containers on the pool deck, please
- There will be no shaving down allowed in the facility

ENTRIES:

- Entries should be electronic on Hy-Tek Team Manager
- Electronic entries should be e-mailed to Sarah Tobin at ccsmeetentries@gmail.com
- All coaches names must be listed in your electronic entry or they will not be allowed on deck
- Each team is allowed up to 4 entries in each individual event
- Teams are allowed two relays per event - only the "A" relay will score. Relays will be seeded according to time, so send an entry time for your "A" relay. Any NT entries will be in the outside lanes. "B" relays will swim in Heat 1. All "A" relays will swim in a scoring, Heat 2, together
- Divers must be included on the entry
- Contestants are allowed to enter a maximum of four events (no more than two individuals)
- Being listed on a relay does not count as an event until the swimmer actually swims the event

- **Entries are due by 12:00 PM on Monday, December 29, 2025.** Entries may be turned in earlier as it would help with the clerical work

There will be a 10-minute break after the 50 Freestyle.

AWARDS: The top 3 participants in each event will be recognized on the bulkhead/podium immediately following the completion of the boy's event.

SCORING: Championship scoring will be used.

Individual Events: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

Relay Events: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

MEDICAL FORMS: Please make sure you have all medical forms with you for all of your swimmers and divers during the competition

CONDUCT: Absolutely **NO** speakers will be permitted in the pool area. Remember, OHSAA rules prohibit balloons and banners other than team banners from being displayed. Banners may not obstruct spectators' view

USA OBSERVATION: This meet will be USA observed; therefore, all USA Swimming registered athletes who are members in good standing at the time of the swim will have their times uploaded to SWIMS. Please make sure you have submitted the athlete's full and correct first name, last name, date of birth and USA Swimming ID # in the database to ensure that the times are uploaded. DIVING

Divers can choose a six or eleven-dive format. This decision will be made by each individual diver and his/her coach. In the case of the 6-dive, dual meet format, divers will choose from the voluntary dive list. The divers doing 6 dives will go first and will be done after their 6th dive. Any diver attempting 11 dives will automatically place above a diver attempting 6 dives.

Diving Entries:

- Dive sheets are due to the entry coordinator by 12:00 PM on Wednesday, December 31, 2025

Where: Diving will be held at Mayfield High School Pool, 6116 Wilson Mills Rd. Mayfield Village, OH 44143

Enter through **Door 16** on the south side of campus.

When: Friday, January 2, 2026

Times: Diving warm-ups begin at 4:30 pm, with competition beginning at 5:00 pm (depending on number of divers).

ADMISSION

Tickets can be purchased online or at the gate. Cash or card may be used at Mayfield. Only cash will be accepted at CSU.

No passes will be accepted. Senior citizens must purchase a student ticket. Diving is a separate event and will require a specific ticket.
