Ohio State Laws that are applicable to Ohio Swimming sanctioned events	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ohio's Return to Play Law (ORC 3313.539 and ORC 3707.511) requires that coaches and referees either (1) complete a free online training once every three (3) years in recognizing the symptoms of concussion or (2) hold a pupil-activity program permit from the Ohio State Board of Education. Free online concussion training is offered through the National Federation of State High School Association and Centers of Disease Control. Training links can be found at www.swimohio.com under Safe Sport>Concussion. There will be the required number of certified lifeguard(s) on duty at all times at this meet per Ohio Administrative Code 3701-31-04-E-4.

Entering the Meet	
Eligibility:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Entry Time Standard: within .50 seconds per 50 yards of at least an OH SC JO Time Standard. No Time standard 15 & Over swimmers. The host reserves the right to enter any of their swimmers. All contestants must be verified USA Swimming members. Membership will not be verified at the meet. Membership verification deadline is 12:00 PM EST on Friday February 2/27/26 for advance electronic entries. Unverified swimmers will be scratched from the meet after that deadline. There will be no refunds for unverified swimmers scratched from the meet. Entries at the door or after noon must present proof of registration either from a SWIMS team report OR online membership 'card' verification. All adult athletes must hold current Athlete Protection Training certification. Age on the first day of the meet will determine age for the entire meet.
Swimmers with a Disability:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ohio Swimming welcomes swimmers with a disability. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations or modifications, including the need for personal assistants and/or registered service animals, must provide advance notice in writing, accompanying their meet entry file, to the meet referee by the entry deadline. Failure to provide advance notice may limit the host's ability to accommodate all requests. <u>Coaches may use the Necessary Accommodation Form to satisfy this requirement.</u> (see entry chair if form is needed).
Entry Limits Entry Fees:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Swimmers may swim a maximum of THREE (3) individual events per day plus relays. \$8.00 per individual event. \$12.00 per Relay. \$4 OH LSC surcharge per swimmer. \$6 Facility fee per swimmer.
Electronic Entry Procedures:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Electronic entries in advance are preferred. (Note membership verification implications above). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Deadline for receipt of ADVANCED entries is THURSDAY 2/26/26, 12:00pm with proof of registration in good standing for all athletes from SWIMS. Electronic entries after this date accepted ONLY with SWIMS report showing valid registration. Entries must be submitted in SCY using an electronic meet entry software (Hy-Tek/Team Unify). Send ADVANCE entries via email to: mmanager@cincy-marlins.com. Include team name in the subject. Please include the names of any Outreach swimmers in the email.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Checks made payable to: Cincinnati Marlins, due with signed Waiver at warmup. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please contact Entry Chair with electronic entry submission to arrange for athlete payment at Clerk for electronic entries. "No Time" (NT) entries will NOT be accepted. The Meet Referee reserves the right to limit entries as necessary to manage the timeline and number of competitors and spectators at each session.
Deck Entries:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Deck entries are accepted at the door with proof of registration (see forms in appendix). Swimmer must provide proof of registration thru the Deck Pass app OR the coach may supply a valid registration list from SWIMS before entries will be accepted. Swimmers must provide their first name, last name, date of birth and USA Swimming membership number that exactly matches what is in the USA Swimming database.
Warm-up and Safety Guidelines:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The meet host will provide a complete schedule of warm-up procedures to include lane assignments and times, which must be adhered to by all participants. This information will be distributed in advance of the meet. Warm-ups will be monitored jointly by the Meet Director and Meet Referee (or their special designees). Except during supervised racing starts, swimmers must enter the pool feet first in a cautious manner with one hand in contact with the pool deck. Ohio LSC Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-Up Procedures will be in effect for this meet. No spectators allowed on deck.
Competition Guidelines:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This meet will be a Timed Trial meet. This meet will be contested in SCY. This meet will not be pre-seeded. Deck entries accepted. Flyover Starts may be used at the discretion of the Meet Referee.
Awards:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No Awards at this meet. Results will be posted during the meet and available in Meet Mobile (technology permitting).

General:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hospitality will be provided for officials and coaches during the meet. NO GLASS CONTAINERS permitted. Concessions will be available for limited items. Gym MAY be available for swimmer use. Please check website for specifics. Results & heat sheets will be published on meet mobile (technology permitting) and on the meet page after the meet. The meet will be livestreamed for at home viewing (technology permitting). Spectators will be limited according to Fire Code posted Capacity limits.
Deck Access	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Meet Director and Meet Referee at each site reserve the right to limit deck access in the event of overcrowding, inappropriate behavior or for any reason concerning the safety of the efficient operation of the meet. USA Swimming Rules of Conduct will be strictly enforced. Non-Athlete Registration cards do NOT grant access to the pool deck at any time. Only Volunteers, Coaches and Officials signed up to work/attend the event will be permitted on deck.
Code of Conduct	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any individual who exhibits a behavior of a threatening, abusive, or derogatory manner toward an official or member of meet operations is subject to immediate removal and further expulsion from the meet. Coaches will be notified of the actions of their respective teams. Good sportsmanship is expected at all times. Bullying or taunting, foul language or derogatory behavior will not be tolerated and will be subject to immediate removal. All volunteers, spectators, coaches, officials and meet staff are expected to be respectful of others. The Ohio Swimming Code of Conduct governs this meet. The purpose of the Zero-Tolerance Code of Conduct Policy is to establish consistent expectations across the LSC in the best interests of our Athletes and Sport. Locker/Restrooms	
Locker rooms/ restrooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Locker rooms/restrooms will be open for swimmers to quickly change into/out of suits. These locker rooms/restrooms are located Balcony end behind the blocks and are for athletes ages 17 and Under only - Adults ages 18 and Over are not permitted to use these locker rooms/restrooms. At no time should swimmers congregate in the locker rooms/restrooms. Adults ages 18 and Over must use restrooms located in the Jim Brower Hallway - athletes ages 17 and Under are not permitted to use the Jim Brower Hallway restrooms. Adults ages 18 and Over are not permitted to use not locker rooms/restrooms designated for athletes/children ages 17 and Under. A family restroom is located in the hallway between the main entry and pool deck.
