Medical Supervision available to athletes	Keating Natatorium has 2 automated external defibrillators (AED's) located at each end of the pool. Certified and trained Lifeguards are also on deck during all warmups and competition sessions.		

#### **Organization Regulations/Waivers USA Swimming Rules** At a sanctioned competitive event, all USA Swimming athletes must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach. Arrangements for coach supervision must be made in advance of the meet. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Use of cameras, cell phones or any other recording device is not permitted immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) during race starts, competition and warm-ups. Please refer to the Safe Sport section of the Ohio Swimming, Inc. policies and procedures for further information regarding the use of visual recording devices. Deck changes are prohibited. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Flash photography is not permitted at the start of any race. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Per USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1F, 12 & Under athletes may not compete in Technical Suits at this meet. Please **Technical Suit Ban** refer to the USA Swimming rulebook for definitions of a technical suit. Ohio State Laws that Ohio's Return to Play Law (ORC 3313.539 and ORC 3707.511) requires that coaches and referees either (1) are applicable to Ohio complete a free online training once every three (3) years in recognizing the symptoms of concussion or (2) hold a Swimming sanctioned pupil-activity program permit from the Ohio State Board of Education. Free online concussion training is offered events through the National Federation of State High School Association and Centers of Disease Control. Training links can be found at www.swimohio.com under Safe Sport>Concussion. There will be the required number of certified lifeguard(s) on duty at all times at this meet per Ohio Administrative Code 3701-31-04-E-4. Safe Sport 360 The U.S. Center for Safe Sport program is a comprehensive abuse prevention program dedicated to creating a healthy and positive environment free from abuse for all its members. Components of the program include, but are not limited to, providing education and training, enforcing policies (such as the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy), rules and best practice guidelines, promoting healthy boundaries and mandatory reporting of violations. The Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) prohibits Applicable Adults (as defined) from having one-onone interactions with minor athletes which are not within an observable and interruptible distance from another adult. Applicable Adults are required to abide by this policy in full during this meet. (www.usaswimming.org/maapp) Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. A report to the U.S. Center for SafeSport may be made via telephone at 833-5US-SAFE (833-587-7233) or online at www.uscenterforsafesport.org/report-a-concern. Various state laws may also require reporting to law enforcement or to a designated child protection agency. All athletes aged 18 and older must complete Athlete Protection Training in order to be a USA Swimming registered member in good standing. Any athlete who turns 18 on or after the first day of the start of competition, who has not completed Athlete Protection Training by the first day of competition, will be prohibited from participating in the competition until such time as all membership requirements are completed. Times achieved by an athlete who turns age 18 on or after the first day of competition, who competes in this USA Swimming sanctioned event without completing this membership requirement, will NOT count for qualification or recognition. This includes participation as a member of a relay. #### **Entry Procedures:** Deadline for receipt of entries is 6:00 pm TUESDAY, January 20, 2026. Entries accepted NO EARLIER than 8:00 am EST, TUESDAY December 16. • Entries must be submitted in SCY using an electronic meet entry software (Hy-Tek/Team Unify). Unattached swimmers (not with a team) are encouraged to use Hytek's TM Lite for entry submission. Entries not completed through a team software are subject to a \$50/swimmer surcharge. The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries, if necessary, to manage the timeline and number of competitors and spectators at each session. Warm-up and Safety The meet host will provide a complete schedule of warm-up procedures to include lane assignments and times, **Guidelines:** which must be adhered to by all participants. This information will be distributed in advance of the meet. Warm-ups will be monitored jointly by the Meet Director and Meet Referee (or their special designees). Except during supervised racing starts, swimmers must enter the pool feet first in a cautious manner with one hand in contact with the pool deck. Ohio LSC Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warn-Up Procedures will be in effect for this meet. No spectators allowed on deck. Competition This meet will be contested in SCY. • **Guidelines:** Friday night Timed Finals: Positive Check in all events, will swim fast to slow. Positive check in rules apply. Saturday Prelim/Final 11 & Over: 11-12 Finals will swim Consolation (B) and Championship (A) heats 13 & Older Finals will swim Bonus (C) (bonus heat at the discretion of the host team based on entries), Consolation (B), and Championship (A) heats Scratch rules for Finals apply. All 10 & Under events are Tmed Finals. 11&Over Sunday events are Timed Finals. Flyover Starts may be used at the discretion of the Meet Referee There will be Clerk staging for all 8&Under EVENTS Saturday and Sunday. Positive Check In Friday Night events & 1650 Procedures: Check in will be in the entry hall and opens 15 minutes before Session warm up and closes 60 minutes before the session start time unless otherwise noted on the Order of Events. Swimmers not checked in will not be seeded. Entry fees for a swimmer seeded within the revised limits as posted on the meet webpage and not checked in are forfeited. Entry fees will be refunded for any swimmer NOT given the opportunity to swim and seeded higher than the final limit as posted on the meet webpage (attendance is not required). Timed Final Positive Check In Events - Scratch Penalty: Swimmers who do not appear for their races after checking in will forfeit their next event even if it is the next day; or if this was his/her last swim, his/her club will be fined \$25. Scratch Procedures: Prelim/Final Events	<ul> <li>Any swimmer originally qualifying for a heat in finals in an individual event who fails to scratch at the scratch table by the scratch deadline and does NOT compete in said final shall be barred from his/her next individual event, except as noted in 'Exception for Failure to Compete' below (4.5.6D). A declared false start under USA-S Rule 101.1.3F or deliberate delay of meet under USA-S Rule 101.1.5 is not permitted and will be regarded as a failure to compete.</li> <li>Failure to scratch consolation or championship finals according to the rules above shall result in a \$25.00 penalty fee per event against the swimmer if the event is his/her last event of the meet. The penalty fee shall be billed to the club and paid to the host of the meet.</li> </ul>				
Deck Entries:	Deck entries only for swimmers already entered in the meet, and at discretion of Meet Director where there is an available lane. The fee is \$16.00 per individual event.
