Minutes from previous meeting:

- Approval has been postponed until January Meeting

Financials – JS

- SAC request for missing HOD meeting
 - 4 clubs miss HOD
 - SAC would like to Waive fees due to emergency surgery, but did not have anyone else to attend.
 - Request came after HOD
 - JS motions that the board Waive SAC fees for not attending HOD
 - Seconded by CE
 - 5 clubs were invoiced for not attending HOD



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- Eagle and Trident have already paid.
 - Lifetime and Muskogee are still outstanding but are unsure if they will be clubs this next year.
 - CE all clubs were given notification by at least 2 different board members informing them it was required.
 - DM would anyone like to speak in favor of the motion?
 - Hearing none, let's call motion.
 - All opposed to the motion
 - By unanimous vote Motion does not carry
- Jenks request for sanction deadline missed
 - Jenks sanctioned 3 meets and 2 of them were too late and accrued late fees, because they were requested less than 45 days from day of meet.
 - SE motions to deny Jenks request for late sanction fees.
 - CE seconds
 - JS has invoice KMS late fees, and they have paid.
 - DM – the officers in charge of this part of the LSC has already denied they request. So, they are appealing to the board.
 - DM – does anyone want to speak against the motion?
 - Motion passed by unanimous vote.
- Financial update
 - Net Income through October - \$5,556.38
 - Cash Balance through October - \$480,647.80
 - Now that we have had a number of Sanctions go through, JS and Pam are thrilled with the pledge invoicing process because it easier to see who has paid, who hasn't paid. Splash fees are getting paid.
 - DM – How do we restating Cash Balance? No actually a cash balance.
 - JS – It is not, because that includes our Western Investment account, but those losses in there are in there will not be accounted for until we get the year end accounting entry from Hood and Associates.
 - CE – How long does a team have to splash fees?
 - JS – Financials are due within 14 days from the meet and then a splash fee invoice is sent out with a net 15 days.
 - CE – Why do we give them 14 days to be reported?
 - JS - We went back to the rule book and the rule book was very clear that expenses needed to be reported to the LSC. So, the delay is to allow hosts to get their expenses together.
 - CE – Does this body care about the expenses for non-LSC meets?
 - JS – the answer is no.
 - BS – But going to the USA Swimming rule book says we have to collect expenses.



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- DM – LSC would have an interest in the expenses. Because we have an interest in the economic health of our members and clubs. Because if we have unprofitable meets, as a body we would be able to ask if we are structuring our sanctions correctly.
- CE – If the club is not making money, they need to figure what needs to be changed and adjust. Does not think that the Board should delay collecting due to expense reporting.
- CE – would like to see that we speed up invoicing.
- DM – suggest that we let the new system run as it is and revisit it in May and see if there are problems then.
- CE – agrees to table discussion until May.
- Jotform update
 - Officials form is ready to go, and link will be up and going on November 22, 2022.
 - Coaches Education/Travel Reimbursement – Just needs the approval steps modified.
 - Modifications to manage additional date we can use to track.
- State meet booklets
 - Goal to have it out be Thanksgiving weekend.
 - SE – Do we put the state cuts in the book?
 - JS – No they are separate.
 - BS – Believe the cuts need to be in the book.
 - JS – Craig need to get list of officials to JS.
 - CH – Understood.

Admin Vice-Chair - SE

- Mighty 2500 Workshop
 - Attending November 4th
 - Evening session was primarily focused on DEI.
 - Concept of DEI was great. Ways to increase the diversity and bring that in and make it a cohesive part of the group was very good.
 - Saturday – Morning was practiced some group activities.
 - Friendships and connections with other LSC mighty 2500 were made.
 - Bringing back ideas of ways to better connect with our own LSC.
 - How we want to create our board? Good materials we could look at regarding ideas of what we are looking at to increase the diversity and the balanced of the board.
