Locations

- State will be hosted at Jenks- July 23-25
 - Deck capacity currently at 210
 - With more deliberation, OKS hopes to host meet
- Division II Meet will be hosted at Edmond- July 16-18
 - Deck capacity currently at 250
 - Has expressed explicit interest in OKS hosting

Hosting

- OKS intends to host all Division II and State meets from this point forward
 - Only case where this will not occur is if OKS cannot reach agreement with facility or team

State Format

- Format same as Spring 2021 meet, with the exception that meet will be swum at one facility
 - Sessions will be swum as Girls Prelims, Boys Prelims, Combined Finals
 - 10 and Unders will swim in finals
 - Relays will be swum during prelims
 - For summer only, relays will be split by age group
- Deck access
 - Only those who are swimming in finals will be allowed on deck during finals session
 - Alternates will be allowed on deck during finals
 - Stress will be placed upon coaches for enforcing who is allowed on deck
- Time trials
 - Time trials will be available at the discretion of meet referee
- B finals for 11&12 and 13&14
 - Will not be adding to summer meets due to timeline concern
 - Will reconsider at a later meeting
- Awards and Walk Outs
 - Podiums and walkouts will not be included in the format of the summer meet
 - Team awards will not be given out on Sunday night
 - Team awards will be announced and pushed out on social media as soon as possible after the meet

Division II Format

- Format similar to Spring 2020
 - 2¹/₂ day meet format
 - Friday combined timed finals
 - Saturday/Sunday prelims-finals
 - Split prelims sessions (girls prelims, boys prelims) and combined finals
 - 10 and Unders at finals
 - Will have contingency that if numbers allow, prelims will be combined

Time Standards

- Time standards will remain the same as whatever is posted on the OKS webpage
 - These should be the 2019 times

Disability Access

- Will be starting disability heats/cuts starting in Spring 2022
 - George will come up with cuts based on USA Swimming guidelines
 - Summer meet will not include these times or heats
 - Publicize this situation via social media and heat sheets over coming year
- Consider encouraging disability team centered in Edmond to register as USA Swimming team
