## Referee Instructions:

- Three timers must be furnished by the requested individual, if a timing system backup is desired. Assigned lane timers may not perform this action.
- All split requests must be submitted to the Referee at least 30 minutes prior to the heat.
- If an initial distance split request is obtained for a backstroke event, the Stroke \& Turn official in whose jurisdiction the finish occurs must confirm that a legal backstroke finish was made at the finish of the split distance.
- The official time from the timing console printout as well as the watch times will be written on the request form. If the back-up times are needed, watch pad adjustments for the heat should be made in accordance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations.
- The official time will be entered into the meet database in a new event created by the Meet Administrative Official for this purpose. For standardization, the event number for such split requests will begin at 900 or greater.
