FACILITY:	<ul> <li>Chuck Fruit Aquatic Center is an indoor 8-lane, 25-yard course. It is equipped with an automated timing system and digital scoreboard. There is an elevated seating area provided for up to 499 spectators with additional deck seating for over 200 athletes and coaches. The minimum water depth for racing starts has been measured in accordance with Article 103.2.32. Pool depth is 7 feet at the starting end, and 13 feet at the turn end.</li> <li>The competition course has been certified in accordance with current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 104.2.2C(4). 	Swimmers may enter a maximum of 10 individual events and 2 relay events for the weekend. Swimmers may enter a maximum of 3 individual events on Friday, a maximum of 4 individual events on Saturday and Sunday, and a maximum of 1 relay event on Saturday and Sunday.			
	Relay teams must be designated A, B, C, etc. if more than one per club is entered per event.			
	<ul> <li>Swimmers may not have any individual "A" times in any event/course during the 2022 A         Champs qualifying period. A meet recon will be run on October 31 and again on         November 7, 2022 to ensure that no A times are earned by entered swimmers after the         entry deadline. Any swimmer earning an A time after entering the meet will be giver         a full refund for all events and removed from the meet.</li> </ul>

SEEDING:	All events, may be pre-seeded. The host team reserves the right to deck seed the meet if a large percentage of no show swimmers is reported prior to the start of the meet.
	<ul> <li>Events 13 &amp; 14 (400 Individual Medley), 41, 42, 53 &amp; 54 (500 Freesytyle) and 65 &amp; 66 (1000 Freestyle) will require a positive check-in to swim.</li> </ul>
	Positive check-in will close at the conclusion of warm-ups each session.
	SWIMMERS MUST POSITIVELY CHECK-IN TO BE SEEDED IN THE EVENT
	All events will be swum fast to slow.
	Distance events will be swum fastest to slowest and alternating heats of girls and boys.
	• Limited Events: Events 13 & 14 (400 Individual Medley), 41, 42, 53 & 54 (500 Freesytyle) and 65 & 66 (1000 Freestyle) may be limited to ensure reasonable timelines. If these events are limited, teams will be informed by Saturday, October 29 and will be given until Wednesday, November 2 to request alternate events. Swimmers who choose to remain entered in the event and end up outside of the limited number have until November 30 to request a refund.
	<ul> <li>Positive check-in Procedures: Positive check-in sheets will be on tables in the pool entry way. Swimmers will use a check mark to indicate that they are present and will swim the event.</li> </ul>
FEES:	<ul> <li>Individual events: \$5.00 per event</li> <li>Relay events: \$10 per relay team</li> <li>Swimmer Surcharge: \$20 per swimmer</li> <li>\$2 of the per swimmer surcharge is paid to Ozark Swimming. The remaining surcharge amount is being retained by the host club.</li> <li>Checks should be made payable to: FAST.</li> <li>Mail payment to: P.O.Box 8595, St. Louis, MO 63126.</li> <li>Payment must be received by November 18, 2022, the first day of the meet. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.</li> </ul>
AWARDS:	12&Under heat winners will receive awards. A High point winner cap for the following age groups: 7&Unders, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, & 18 year olds.
SCORING	Standard scoring will be used for individual events to determine highpoint winners. Relay events will not be scored. Team scores will not be awarded.
SAFETY	Lifeguards, with access to an AED device, will be available to athletes participating in the meet.
RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.
	<ul> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> </ul>
	The flyover start procedure will be used for all sessions.
	<ul> <li>Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not permitted.</li> </ul>
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	<ul> <li>Deck access is restricted to USA Swimming athletes, coaches, officials and meet volunteers. All non-athlete members must have proof of registration or a credential while on deck and present them upon meet management request. USA Swimming app is acceptable proof of USA Swimming membership.</li> </ul>
	o Coaches who have valid USA Swimming credentials but who are unable to provide them upon request will be issued temporary credentials by the meet director

	o Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck	
	area.	
	<ul> <li>Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP)" and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>A quality control system has been implemented to ensure that individuals who are ineligible for participation are unable to participate in this competition. This includes, without limitation, individuals listed on the U.S. Center for SafeSport's Disciplinary Database, USA Swimming's List of Individuals Permanently Suspended or Ineligible for Membership, USA Swimming's List of Individuals Suspended or Ineligible-Specific Date, and all adult members (defined by the SafeSport Code for the Olympic and Paralympic Movement as 18 years and over) of USA Swimming who have not completed athlete protection education as required by the U.S. Center for SafeSport.</li> </ul>	
OFFICIALS:	Officials will be needed for all positions and all sessions for this meet.
