DECK CHANGING	exception, USA Swimming registered and credentialed coaches are permitted to utilize visual recording devices to record their swimmers in the pool for the sole purpose of stroke training, subject to the location restrictions of this statement, so long as they do not interfere with meet operations. In the event of any disputes regarding video recording, the Meet Referee's decision shall be final and binding. In no case shall coaches be permitted to delegate this role to athletes.		
DECK CHANGING	Per USA Swimming rule 202.4.10(I), deck changes are prohibited.		
PRE-MEET INFORMATION AND RESULTS	A technical bulletin will be e-mailed to all participating clubs prior to the meet which w include estimated timelines, warm-up assignments and any other pertinent information.

RESTRICTIONS	As provided under 202.4.10(L), It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

	Sale and use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in all areas of the meet venue.		
	No glass containers are allowed in the meet venue		
RULES	In accordance with USA Swimming rule 202.4.10J, unless approved in writing in advance of the completion by the Program & Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone of any other flying apparatus is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectate areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectate are present. In accordance with USA Swimming rule 102.8		
	 Swimsuits for men may not extend above the naval or below the knee and for women may not cover the neck or extend past the shoulders or below the knee. Swimsuits worn for competition must be non-transparent and conform to the current 		
	concept of appropriate.		
	3. No swimmer is permitted to wear or use any device, substance or swimsuit to help his/her speed, pace, buoyancy or endurance during a race. Goggles may be worn, and rubdown oil may be applied if not considered excessive by the Referee. Therapeutic elastic tape is prohibited. Any other kind of tape on the body is not permitted unless approved by the Referee.
