	Pool Specifications The Homestead High School Pool is a 25-yard, 8 lane pool with anti-turbulent laneline backstroke flags. The pool depth is 13 feet at the block-end. We use a Colorado of Timing System with semi-automatic buttons on each lane, and manual back up wate 22" blocks at the start. There are no backstroke wedges or track blocks. All 25-yard so will start off the bulkhead that is at a 4'8" pool depth. The meet host will ensure required course dimensions.	
Facility	Timing All events will be timed using a Colorado Gen7 Timing System with horn start, touch pads, one backup button, and two watches as backup. 25-yard races will finish at the touchpad, and will be timed with one backup button and two watches as backup. The 25-yard races will start off the bulkhead at the turn end of the pool. Athletes will have the choice to start off the side, or in the water.	

	First Aid/Medical A certified lifeguard will always be present throughout warmup and the duration of the meet. Please report all injuries to the lifeguard and meet director. Should the situation arise, first aid, AED devices, and access to an emergency medical team will be available. EMS can be contacted, if needed, via the lifeguard on duty.
	An Officials Meeting will be held one hour before the starting time for each session in the officials' room. Anyone wishing to officiate at this meet should sign up on the Meet Landing Page or contact the Meet Referee, Jeff Meyer.
Officials	Officials must have valid USA Swimming registration and must be working that session to be on deck. The official mobile application of USA Swimming is acceptable proof of USA Swimming Membership.
	Timers Briefings will be held 30 minutes before the start of each session.
	Deck access is restricted to participating athletes, coaches, working officials and meet personnel. Credentials will be issued and must be displayed at all times while on deck. This will be strictly enforced by Meet Marshals and other meet staff.
	Parents/guardians are NOT allowed on deck or in the locker rooms at any time.
Deck Access	Parents and other non-swimmers not involved in the running of the meet are requested to remain in designated spectator areas. The Meet Director and Meet Referee reserve the right to limit deck access in the event of overcrowding, inappropriate behavior or for any reason concerning the safety or the efficient operation of the meet. USAS Rules of Conduct will be strictly enforced.
	Coaches may pick up meet packets in the admin office and must sign-in at the start of each session
Spectator Admission	An admissions surcharge will be collected per athlete as part of the meet entry/registration fees. Handicapped seating is on deck. View may be obstructed by coaches, officials, and athletes. Please contact the Meet Director for seating accommodations. Heat sheets will not be made available for purchase, but a QR code with access to an electronic version will made available. Meet Mobile will also include heat sheets.
Parking	Parking is available within all lots located around Homestead High School. Athletes, parents, and coaches will find the best entrance through Door 21.
Lost and Found	Please check the lost and found area, near the spectator entrance of the pool. The facility and the meet host are not responsible for lost items. Items not picked up by the end of the meet will be discarded or donated.
Concessions	Concessions will be available in the hallway adjacent to the pool.

Breaks may be scheduled as needed and will be determined by meet management before the start of the meet. Meet management would determine the duration of each break. During breaks, the competition pool will not be open for warm-up/warm-down. However, the warm-up pool will be available throughout the duration of the meet. This meet will be run using fly over starts.

RULES and PROCEDURES

RULES and PROCE	<u>DURES</u>
Official Rules	Official current USA Swimming and Wisconsin LSC rules shall prevail for this meet except as otherwise specified in this meet information. Participating athletes must be registered USA Swimming athletes and in good standing. The athlete's age on February 20 th , 2026 determines age group for the entire competition. All coaches and officials are required to sign in and prove that their USA Swimming membership is in good standing and all certifications are current. The official mobile application of USA Swimming should be used for proof of USA Swimming membership. All USA Swimming athletes must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist an unaccompanied swimmer make arrangements for such supervision, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.
Deck Registration	No deck registrations will be accepted at this meet.
Para/Disability Swimming	Please note any special requirements and/or requests for a swimmer with disability with your meet entry. All requests for swimmers with disabilities must be received before the start of the meet and presented to the meet referee. The WSI Para Accommodation Form shall be used for all accommodation and/or modification requests
Start Certification	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
MAAPP	All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Times achieved by an athlete member at a sanctioned/approved meet who is over 18 years of age who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (or whose APT training had expired) by the date of the swim, will not be able to be uploaded to SWIMS. This includes participation as a member of a relay. These athletes will also be considered "not in good standing" and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1.
Warm-up Procedures	Warm up times and lanes may be assigned. Assignments will be posted on the meet landing page and communicated to each team. Assigned time blocks will be a minimum

of 25 minutes of warm ups with a 15-minute controlled warm up for starts/pace for all athletes at the end of the warm up session.

USA Swimming and Wisconsin Swimming warm-up procedures will be enforced throughout the meet. Circle swimming only, except in designated lanes and times. All entry to pools during open warm-up cool down periods shall be feet first three-point entry from the start end. No snorkels, kickboards or other training devices are allowed during warm-ups. Teams are welcome to do starts, sprint and pace work within their assigned warm-up time, in their assigned lanes. A 15-minute controlled warm-up for starts/pace for all athletes at the end of the warmup session.

Swimmer(s) without a coach present are to report to the Meet Director prior to warm-ups for lane assignment.

In-Meet Warmup: An entire 8-lane 25-yard pool will be available for warm-up throughout the duration of the meet. Athletes are advised to limit the amount of flipturns done on the bulkhead to avoid clashing with the competition pool.

Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and will see that their club has proper supervision at all times. Meet Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer and/or spectator from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior, damage to property, etc. No smoking on the premises. Parents and swimmers are encouraged to clean up after themselves after each session

- No underwater video recording equipment is allowed at any time during the meet.
- No glass containers of any kind are allowed on deck or in locker room areas
- No coolers, chairs, blankets or large bags will be allowed in the balcony or hallways.
- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in the changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms.
- Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. Deck changes are prohibited.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- Flash photography will not be allowed during the start of any heat. Individuals
 using flash photography near the start of a heat may be ejected from the meet
 facility.

All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of Wisconsin Swimming and the meet host under the conditions authored by Wisconsin and USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in this Wisconsin Swimming competition to promote such competitions.

Conduct

All events are Timed final events with FLY-OVER starts.

All events longer than 400Y will be positive check-in and swam fast to slow.

Positive check-in will close 30 minutes after the start of the warm-up period for the upcoming session.

Meet Format

Meet management reserves the right to combine any events longer than 200Y.

Breaks may be inserted at the discretion of meet management. Depending on duration, the competition pool may or may not be open for warm-ups during these breaks. All added breaks will be posted to the session report and communicated to lead coaches.

Seeding

All events will be pre-seeded and swam slow to fast, except for events longer than 400Y will be positive check-in and swam fast to slow. Meet management reserves the right to combine any event longer than 200Y.

ENTRY INTO THE MEET

LINITE INTO THE	
Swimmer Eligibility	All swimmers must be current Wisconsin LSC registered athlete members of USA Swimming and in good standing. All individual swimmers entered in the meet shall be eligible to swim in the meet. Any swimmer who swims in the meet and is found ineligible will be disqualified from the meet, forfeit all awards and points achieved and their club fined. The representative submitting entries shall be responsible for verifying that all swimmers satisfy eligibility requirements.
Qualifying Times	8 & Under, 10 & Under, 11-12, and 13-14 swimmers may not swim in an event in their age group in which they have achieved a state cut prior to entry deadline IN ANY COURSE (SCY, SCM, LCM). A swimmer that achieves a state cut after the entry deadline may still swim that event at the Regional meet. Swimmers may not swim a Senior event if they have achieved the Senior state cut prior to the entry deadline. All swimmers who have achieved state cuts may swim those events in the Senior category if they have not achieved the Senior state cut in that event. An exception may be allowed for swimmers with birthdates (day/month) that are between their Regional and State Championship Meet, which would cause them to move into higher age group qualifying standards. Such swimmers may enter events in which they have their current age State Championship time standard. However, such entries shall be made as "exhibition" (not eligible for points or 'win and in' status). Please contact the entry chair directly for any swimmers in this situation.
Win It-You're In It	Any 12 and under swimmer competing and winning an event of 200 yards or fewer in the 8u, 10u, or 11-12 age categories, regardless of whether they achieved a Wisconsin State Qualifying Standard, will be qualified to compete in that event during the 2026 Wisconsin Swimming's SCY State Championships. Swimmers will be seeded at the slowest SCY Time Standard in the State Championships.
Entry Limits	A swimmer may compete in not more than eight (8) individual events total for the meet, excluding time trials events. A swimmer may compete in no more than five (5) individual events per day, including time trial events. Time Trials are under a separate sanction and do not apply to the meet event totals, but do apply to the daily event total. Teams may enter unlimited teams in relay events. Swimmers MUST be registered as an athlete in the meet in order to complete in relaysNO RELAY ONLY SWIMMERS. Relays may be held at the discretion of meet management.
Deck Entries	Deck entries are allowed at the discretion of meet management. \$10 per event. If the athlete is not entered into the meet, the appropriate surcharges must also be paid by the athlete. No new heats will be created for Deck Entries. All deck entries must be done at least 30 minutes prior to the session that the events are to be swum. HIGH SCHOOL BOYS DECK ENTRIES

Entry Rules	Deck entries are available for High School boys. New heats may be added to accommodate the added High School boy's entries. High School boy's deck entries will be at the same fees as a regular entry, plus any additional athlete surcharges charged by the meet host. All High School boys MUST be registered with USA/WI Swimming by February 15, 2026 and show proof of registration. Athletes 18 years and older MUST show proof of completion of APT prior to competition ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries must be e-mailed to TomMiazga8@gmail.com by 6:00 PM CST on Friday, February 13 th , 2026. • When emailing entries, please include contact information including name of person submitting the entries, name of LSC club and phone number in case of questions or problems with the entries. • You will receive a confirmation e-mail. If you have not received your confirmation by Sunday, Feb. 15 th , contact the entry chair immediately. • Any entries received after the entry deadline are subject to a \$150 late fee. Entries submitted after Monday, February 16 th will not be accepted. Teams are allowed to send in an updated entry by Monday, February 16 th @ 8:00pm. • Any non-electronic (Team Manager or Team Unify) are subject to a \$20 per athlete fee. • When entering a disabled athlete into the meet, please be sure to include any needed documentation used to determine P1, P2 or P3 designated disability
	placement. A non-refundable check for entry fees and surcharges must be received before the start of the meet. You may bring waiver and payment to the pool.

Awards	The following age groups will be used for scoring and awards: 8 and under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14. Open/Senior events are not awarded. 1st through 16th place ribbons will be awarded for individual events. 1st through 8th place ribbons will be awarded for relay events. Individual High Point Awards: 1st - 3rd Place for each gender in each Age Group will be awarded (with the exception of Senior Events). Points awarded to 14-Under athletes competing in any Senior event will not count toward Age Group High Point. No award presentations will take place. All awards will be bagged and can be picked up at the conclusion of the meet. No awards will be mailed. Awards not picked up will be brought to state meets.
Scoring	Individual events will be scored using 16 place scoring. Relay events will score double. 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1
Results	Unofficial Live Results will be available on Meet Mobile if technology allows.

When:	At the conclusion of the afternoon session, as time permits, and at the discretion of the meet director. Pool will be open for a 10 minute warm-up period following the conclusion of the afternoon session.			
Eligibility:	Only athletes already entered in the meet are eligible to participate in the Time Trial portion of this meet. Exception: High School boys may enter into the Time Trial portion without having participated in			
	the meet, however that athlete MUST be registered with USA Swimming AND be registered for a club participating in their respective Regional meet.			
	All High School boys MUST be registered with USA/WI Swimming by February 15, 2026 and show proof of registration. The official mobile application of USA Swimming is acceptable proof of USA Swimming membership. Athletes 18 years and older MUST show proof of completion of APT prior to competition.			
Events:	See meet order of events listing. Events and or Genders may be combined at the discretion of the head official and the meet directors. The order of events will be as follows: Free, back, breast, fly, IM and starting at the shortest distance (25y) and progressing up to the longest (1650y). The 1000 and 1650 free will be run last as a combined event. Where possible, athletes will fill empty lanes of the 1000 and 1650 Free during the competition sessions to avoid time trial heats.			
Time Limit:	The host reserves the right to limit the time trials to 1 hour. If swims do not make it by the time limit, those fees will be refunded.			
Entry Limit	SWIMMERS ARE ALLOWED UP TO SIX (6) EVENTS PER DAY. PLEASE NOTE: Time Trials are under a separate sanction and therefore do not fall under the eight (8) events per meet. However, swimmers are NOT allowed to swim more than six (6) events per day which include a combined total of Competition Session events and Time Trial events.			
Fee	\$10.00/individual event AND \$20/RELAY EVENT.			
Registration	Registrations will be accepted up until 2:30 pm each day afternoon. ONLY ATHLETES ASSIGNED TO THAT REGIONAL ARE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN THE TIME TRIALS (Unattached Athletes NOT attached to a specific team but registered as a Wisconsin Athlete may compete). Swimmers, who sign up for a time trial event and make the state cut time after the registration deadline, will be refunded upon request.			
Procedures	Swimmer(s) will sign up for an event at the Scorer's Table underneath the scoreboard. Swimmer(s) will fill out a seed card at the office—swimmer's name, age, team, event name and seed time. Seed card and event fee must be turned in to the office before the deadline (above). A meeting for time trials participants will be held prior to the start of time trials. It is the swimmer's responsibility to be ready to swim when his/her event is called. The referee will not hold the start of the event to wait for a swimmer to show. An announcement will be made that time trials are beginning and swimmers should report to the meeting immediately.
