12&U

- Plan that the summer meet will typically be smaller
 - Used the slower 2023 Spring cuts and no event conflicting with it (All City) – still small
 - Only 41 teams participated – smallest meet in 10+ years
- Swim 8&U Separate from 10&U
- Tweak Event order so all 8&U Events are not in a row on Sunday
- More breaks, spread out swims
- Maybe use 8&U events as breaks
- Post/Announce Team Scores throughout meet
- Post Highpoint throughout meet
- LCM 400 medley relay and 100 fly were difficult back to back
 - Either put the 400 medley relay at the end of the session or change the 50 fly and 100 fly by days but if the 50's are changed that would put (3) 50's in one session. That is a challenge for the meet host to have 3 50's in one day.
- All awards should be available throughout the meet.

- Very small meet (we were cautious after the Spring 11-14 meet).
 - Stick with the Spring time standards.
 - Allow 4 bonus swims or allow 3, then have a 2nd deadline to add another bonus race, if the meet is small.
- 13-14 swims on the relays - language in the meet information
- 13-14 should have different event numbers than Open for all events, except the 800 & 1500.
 - This will allow 13-14 to go between age groups if they wish.
- Allow anyone to enter an open race of any age.
- Relay qualifiers can swim in both 13-14 and/or open.
- Currently no maximum number of relay limitations for athletes.
- Anybody that has qualified for the meet can swim on open relays.
- 200/400 Finals Relays: Top 16 fastest Open (A and/or B) and the top 8 fastest 13-14 (A and/or B) will compete.
- 800 Free Relays: Top 8 Open (A and/or B) and Top 8 13-14 (A and/or B)
- Voted Majority: every night including Sunday - Relays should end finals session
- 400 Prelim Races: Top 2 heats are circle-seeded.
 - Prelims: Top 2 heats swim, race the relays, then the remaining 400's will alternate girls/boys heats, fastest to slowest
- Review the Order of Events – 200 free on the 800 free relay day (some swimming it 3x/day)
- 13-14 Events For Finals:
 - Top 8: All relays, 400 IM, and 400 free
 - Top Combined fastest 8 Open/13-14 800 free and 1500
 - Top 16 for all 200 distances and shorter
- Open Events For Finals:
 - Top 8: 800 free relay, 800 free (combined with fastest 13-14), 1500 (combined with fastest 13-14)
 - 800/1500 will be combined with Open and top 8 combined fastest times will compete in Finals.
 - Top 16: 400 IM and 400 Free
 - Top 24: All other events 200 and shorter
- * 800/1500 Races: This will be a multi-age event with the fastest 8 competing in Finals. Others will swim alternating girls/boys, fastest to slowest, in prelims. 13-14 will be awarded separately from the Open.
- Look at order of events esp the 200 Free, 400 IM, 100 Fly combo
