 - ii. Encouraged Coaches, Swimmers and/or Parents to send Sara an email when a record has been broken. She does not receive alerts and would appreciate heads up so that she can verify.
- f. OPERATIONAL RISK MANAGEMENT CHAIR Shane Ryan
 - i. Accident reporting has gone up 33% (which is a good thing)
 - ii. Encouraged that it is better to report it no matter how insignificant.
 - iii. Additional Coverage needed for clubs with athletes that are NOT USA Swimming registered.
 - 1. Clarifications Clubs are allowed a 30-day Try-out Coverage.
