The LSC would like to see that all teams attending LSC hosted State Championships provide volunteers for the necessary spots to run a legal meet and avoid any unnecessary delays of starting a session. We do attempt to solicit help from outside the LSC to reduce the requirement from each team.

Summary of Need: Include background, issues and/or events leading up to this proposal. *

When the LSC has hosted state championship meets in the past, there has been a consistent shortfall of the required volunteers from the attending teams. After hosting 2 pool championships, the LSC chose to impose the fee as noted in policy 2.6.1

Multiple teams at the 13+ State meet failed to provide volunteers, most which were ones with a large contingent of athletes entered in the meet. Requests for help from outside the LSC was unsuccessful. Prior to several sessions, the staff was soliciting all spectators for timing and marshal assistance; personnel were moved from other duties to fill vacancies.

The LSC staff feels the current fee is too low and does not impose a sense of urgency for teams to fulfil volunteer requirements. The current fee is \$2.50/athlete entered, with a maximum of \$50 per day of the meet. Depending on the state meet, this penalty only maxes out at \$150 or \$200.

The LSC staff is proposing a change in the per athlete fee to \$10, with a maximum of \$250 per day of the meet.

This would significantly increase the amount of the fee charged to teams and hopefully inspire more to help run a successful meet for the athletes. Otherwise, the higher fee will supplement the budgetary need to cover any financial obligations to obtain help from outside the LSC.
