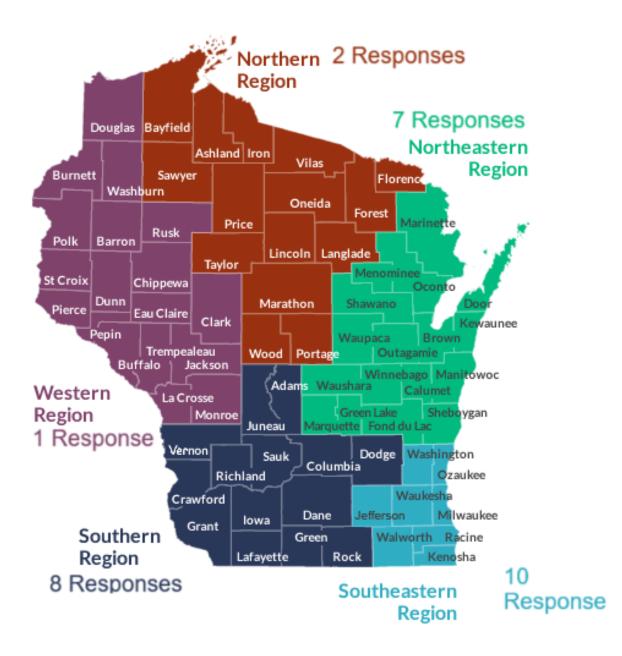

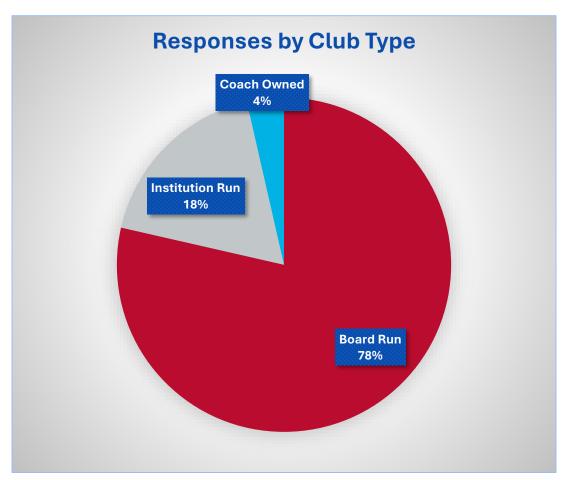


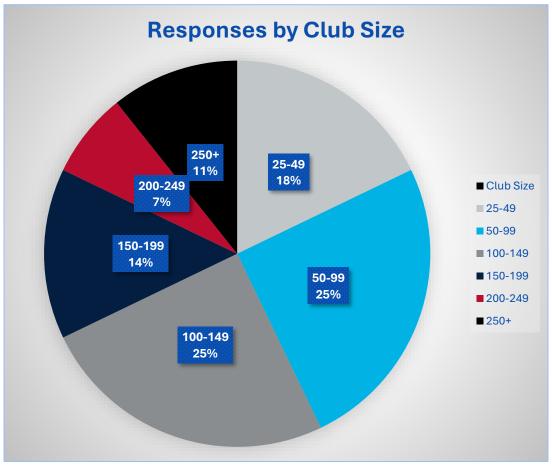


# Response Overview

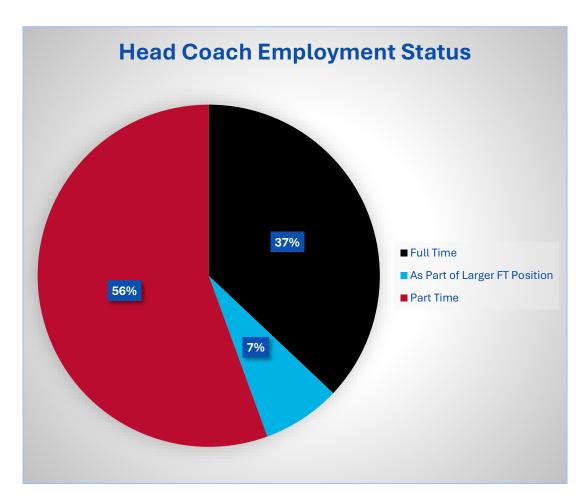
- 28 clubs filled out all or some data, representing 50% of the 56 clubs with Age Group & Senior programming in the Wisconsin LSC.
- 36% of responses from Southeastern
  - 10 of 22 clubs responded, 45%
- 29% of responses from Southern
  - 8 of 13 clubs responded, 61%
- 25% of responses from Northeastern
  - 7 of 16 clubs responded, 43%
- 7% of responses from Northern
  - 2 of 3 clubs responded, 66%
- 4% of responses from Western
  - 1 of 2 clubs responded, 50%

## Respondent Demographics



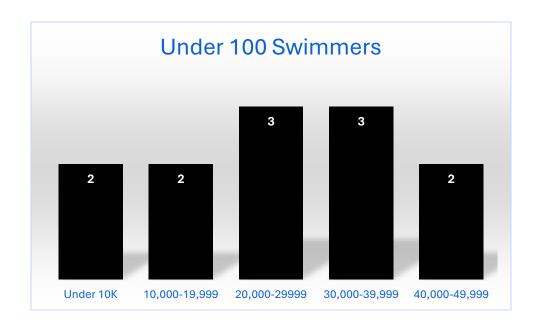

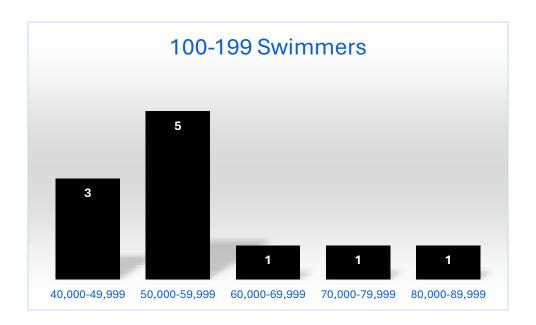


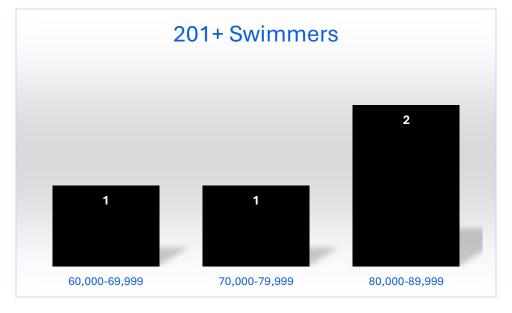


## **HC Salary Breakdowns**



Note: With only 50% of clubs responding, breaking salary numbers into subgroups can lead to less accurate numbers.



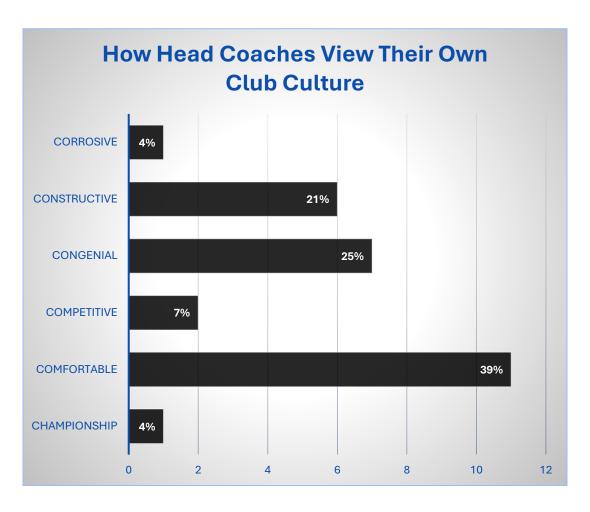


## Head Coach Details, Continued

- In 2019, 20% of coaches paid meet expenses versus 3% in 2024
- Incentives, such as health insurance offerings, have remained similar to 2019
- In 2019, 22% of respondents listed themselves as making under \$10K. Now, only 7%.
  - Theory: many of those clubs either didn't answer in 2024, or don't coach any longer.

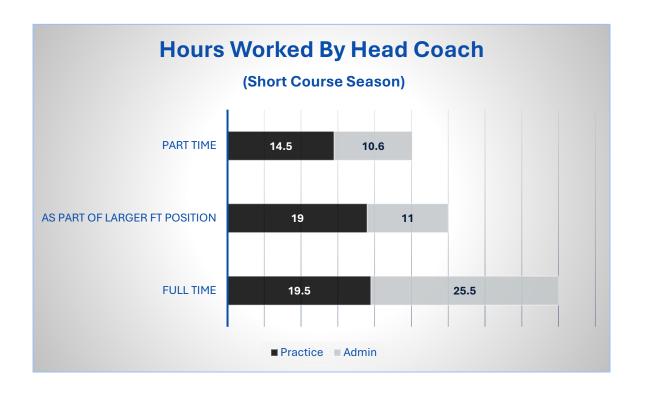
- 64% of Head Coaches on Board Run Clubs have a position on their board

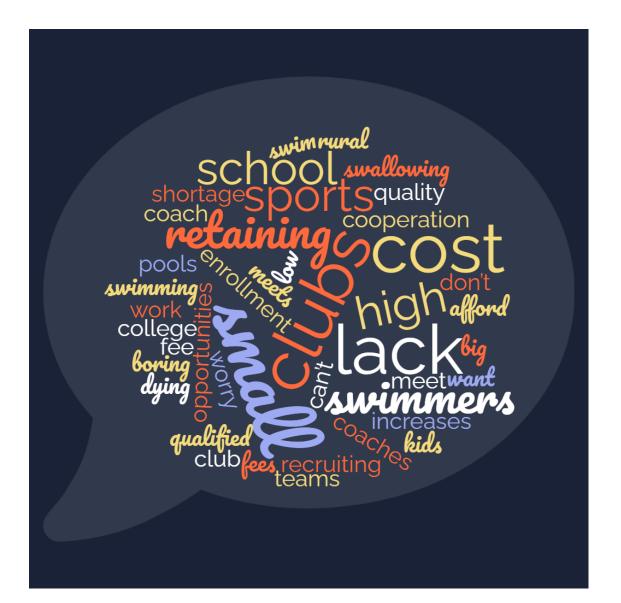

#### **Club Concerns**

The most consistent concerns among programs:

- Aging facilities
- Meet fees
- Finding, retaining quality coaches
- Volunteer buy-in



#### **Sport Concerns**

An overwhelming majority of the concern came in the form of:

- Concern about small clubs
  - Large clubs taking or outright recruiting their athletes
  - Due to aging facilities, difficulty in finding/retaining quality coaches, teams collapsing
- Costs, specifically meet fees
- Retaining swimmers against other sports
  - Meets, even champs meets, can be \*boring\* and without excitement
  - Kinds finding other sports with quicker validation
