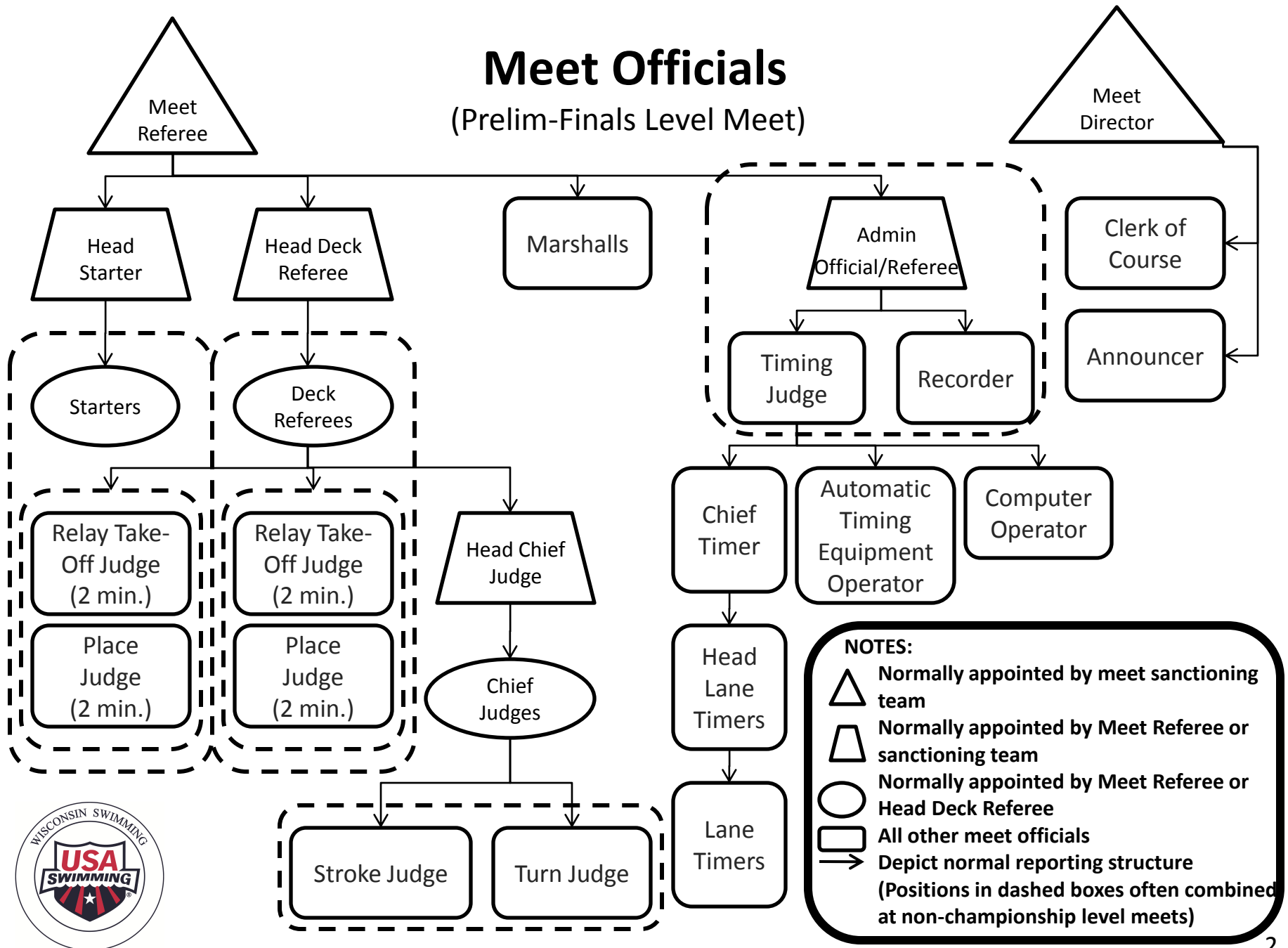

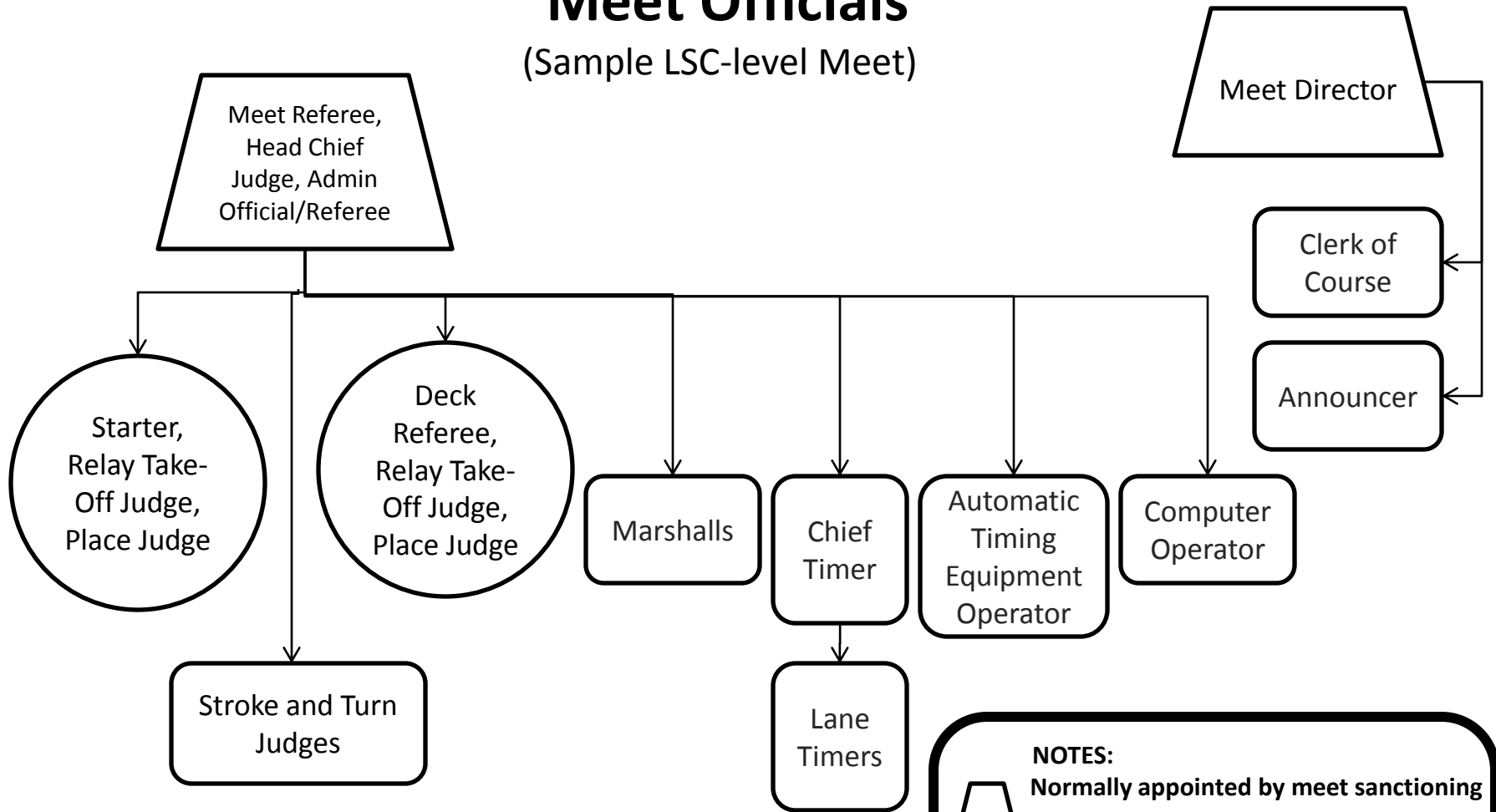

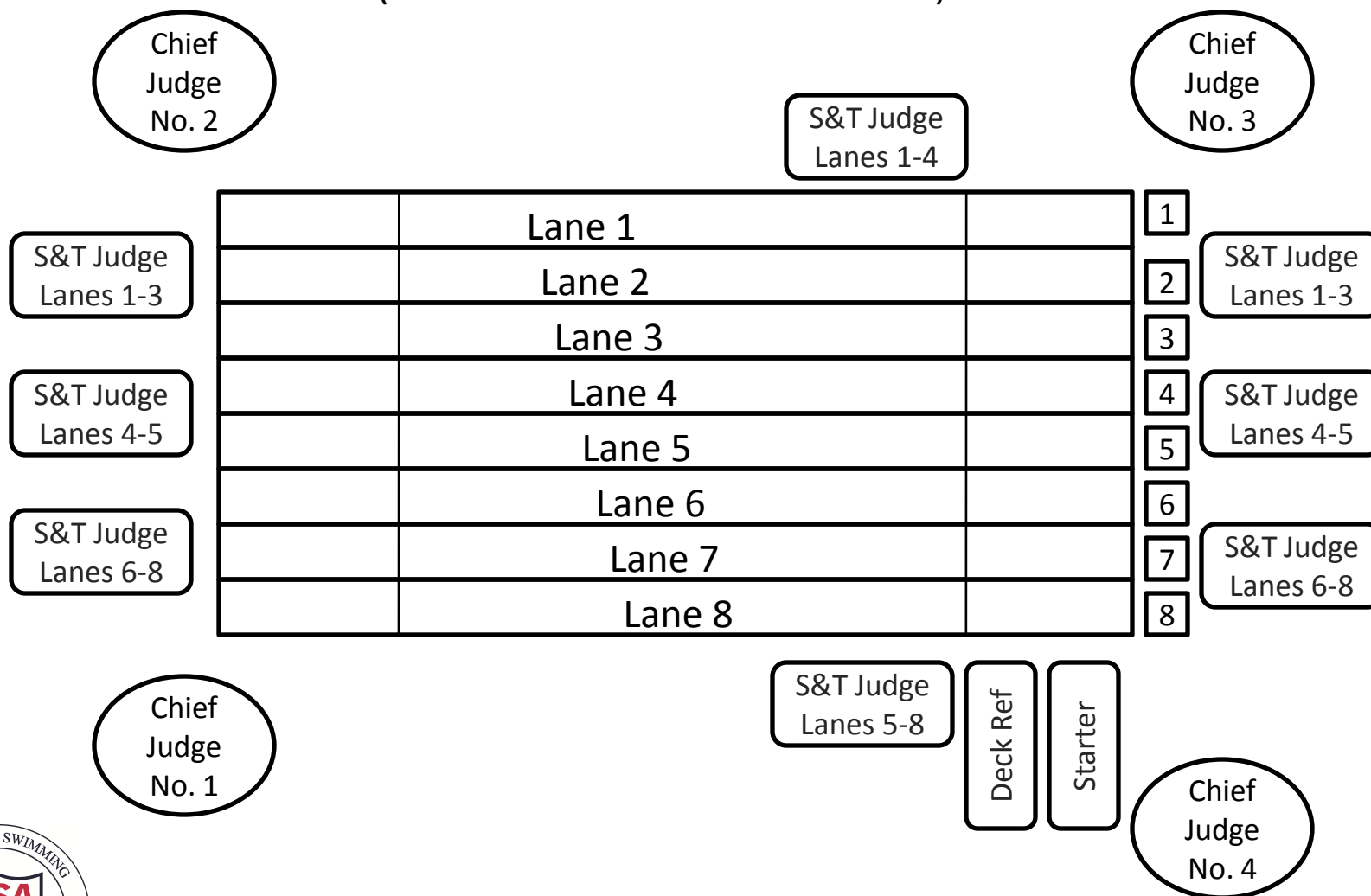


Depict normal reporting structure

(At start of BR and FY event races)

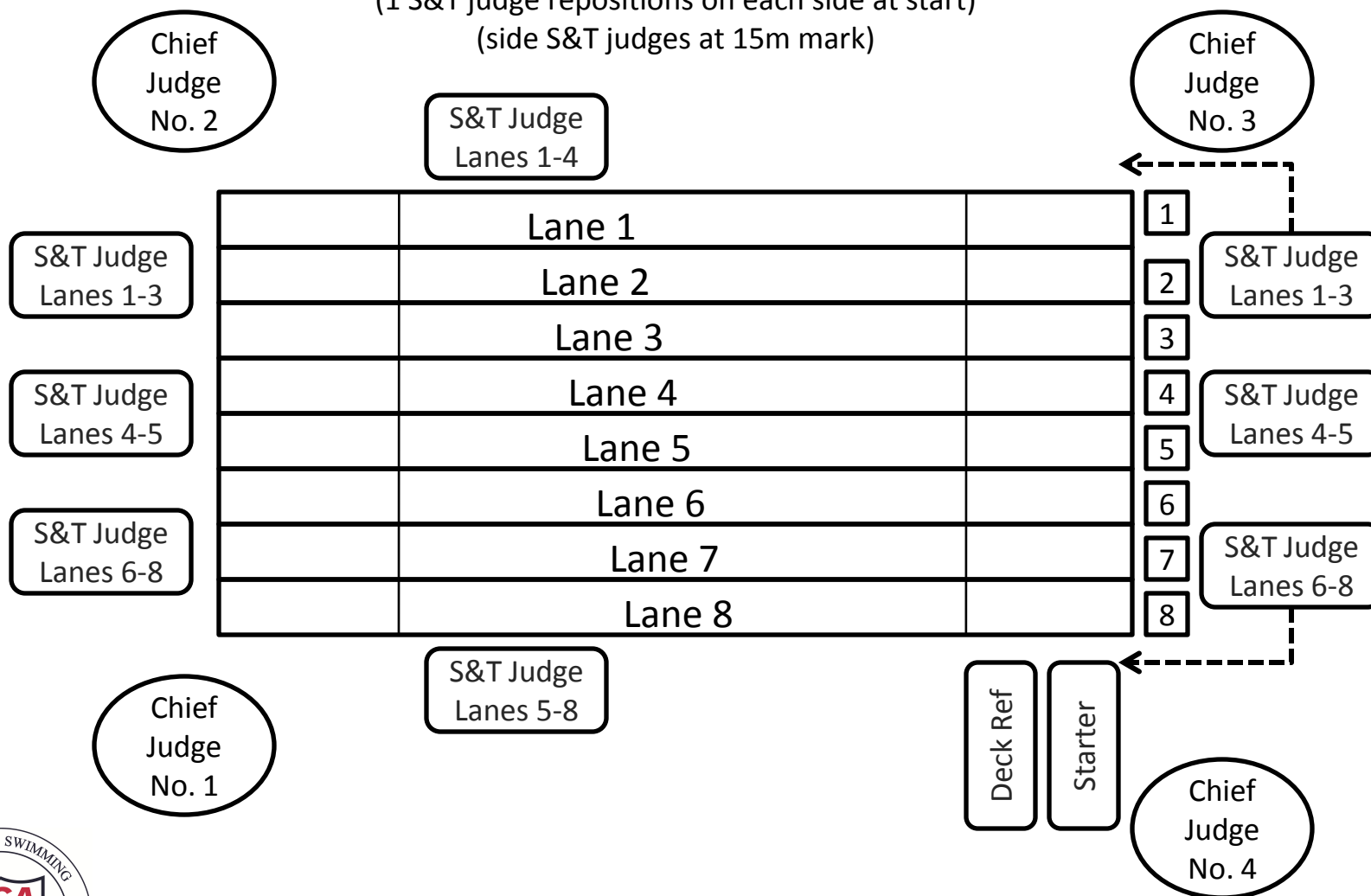


Officials Placement On Deck

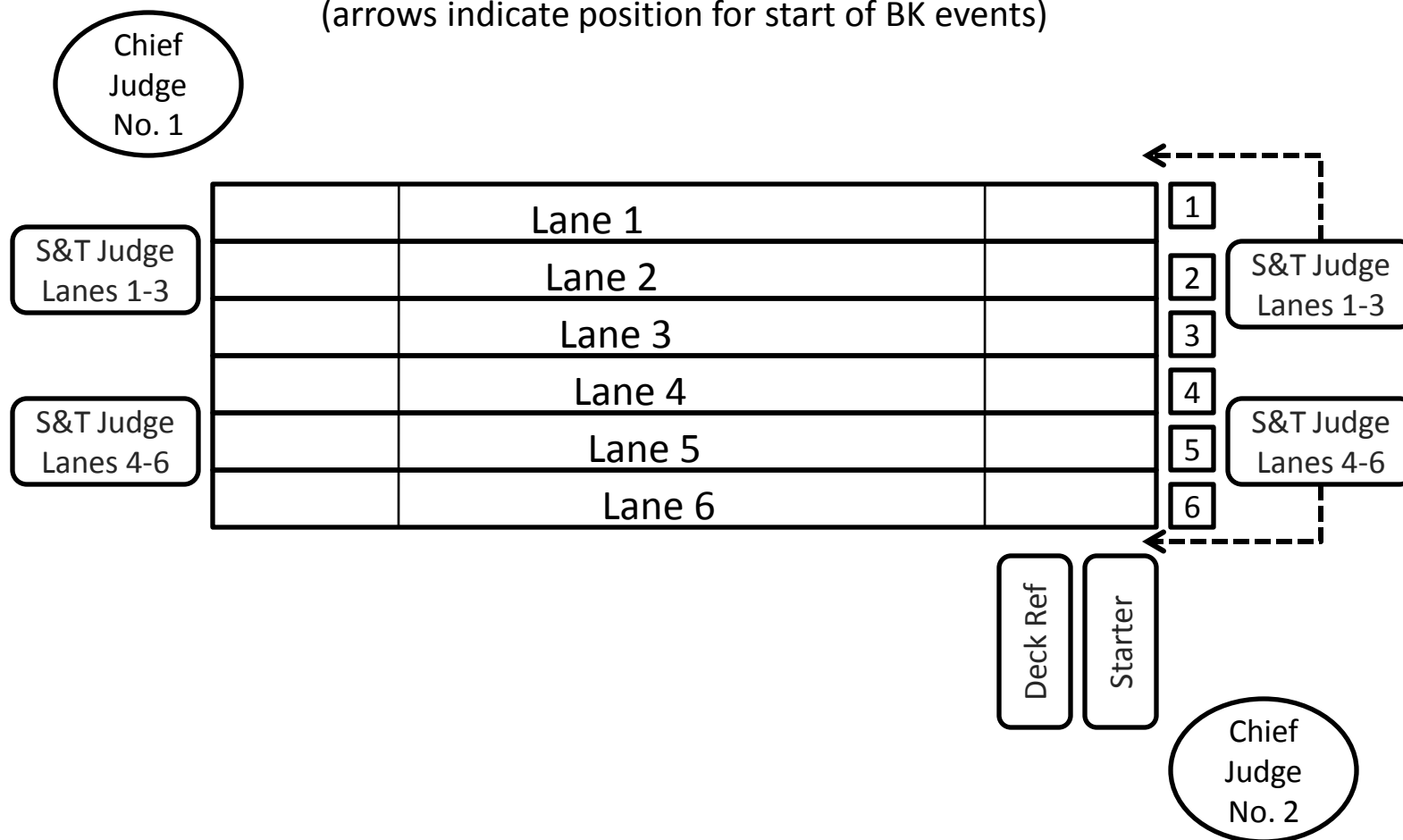

Priorities / Objectives:

- 1) Have a Chief Judge
- 2) Preference of S&T judges being on end of pool, rather than side
- 3) Have Deck Referee and Starter located together in starting area
- 4) Consistent deck coverage throughout all sessions of meet
- 5) Depending upon meet format, consider dropping down a level or two to allow for relief official(s)
