- Take I-295 South for approximately 5.5 miles
- Take National Harbor Exit 1B

FROM MARYLAND

- Merge onto I-495 / I-95 Capital Beltway Inner Loop
- The lanes will divide after you pass Exit 4. Make sure stay in the right lanes in
- order to follow the 'Local Lanes'.
- Take National Harbor Exit 2A

FROM VIRGINIA

- Merge onto I-495 / I-95 Capital Beltway Outer Loop
- As you are approaching the Woodrow Wilson Bridge stay in the right hand
- lanes in order to take the 'Local Lanes'
- Cross the Woodrow Wilson Bridge
- Take National Harbor Exit 2A

Schedule of Events:

Check in begins: 7:30 AM (all swimmers must check in at least 30 minutes before the start of their race) Briefing: 8:00 AM 10 & Under 1 K – 9:00 am 11-12 and 13-14 2 K - 9:45 am

15-18 3 K – 10:30 am

(Men and women in each age group will compete on the same course at the same time.)

If there are a high number of entries in a particular event, the race will be run in heats. If the number of entries for a particular event is so large to cause it to run more than the time allotted above, the meet director will limit the entries for that event.

Weather Delay: If inclement weather causes a delay, a notice will be posted on the Eastern Zone website (http://www.easternzoneswimming.org/) along with the adjusted start times for each race. There will be no rain date.

Facilities: The swimmers will compete in an area of the Potomac River adjacent to the pier. The race course will be marked with large orange buoys. The start will take place in the water just off the pier. There are suppose to be showers provided on the pier for swimmers to rinse off after the swim..

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. Each swimmer must be a 2010 USA Swimming registered athlete in one of the LSC's which make up the Eastern Zone
- 2. Each swimmer must be entered on the official entry forms provided. Only one swimmer per entry form.
- 3. Competition is restricted to Eastern Zone LSC's.
- 4. The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries or conduct the events in heats
- 5. A full refund will be given to swimmers that are eliminated.

COURSE: 400 m x 100 m for all races. 11-12 & 13-14 swimmers will go twice around, 15-18 swimmers will go 3 times around. Water temperature in August is usually between 76-80 degrees. Water depth is 4-12 feet at mean low tide. There is next to no current. Water is clean.

RULES: 2010 USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will govern this event. No drafting allowed. No swimmer shall be allowed to use or wear any device that may be an aid to his/her speed, endurance or buoyancy.

Wet suits, flotation aids or any similar items, and anything used to maintain body heat, except a reasonable application of body grease, are not allowed.

PROTESTS: A Meet Jury will adjudicate any protest including issues of conduct which may occur at the meet venue. All protests must be made in writing. The Meet Jury will consist of the Meet Director, Meet Referee, an Athlete Representative, a Coach Representative and a Non-coach Representative

Safety: Adequate safety guidelines will be strictly adhered to at this meet. Kayakers will be spotting throughout the course and safety craft will be on site and prepared to administer aid should the need arise. The Fire Department Search & Rescue will be the Safety Authority on the water, and the Coast Guard will monitor the surrounding area in order to keep boat traffic away from the course. Meet swim caps will be provided and must be worn by all competitors.

AWARDS: Zone Open Water medals for first through eighth places. <u>*Please Note:*</u> The results of the Open Water Competition will not affect the team score from the Eastern Zones Meet.
