# East Bay Bat Rays Swimming Learn To Swim

#### **About The Program**

The East Bay Bat Rays Swim Team (EBAT) is a non -profit organization that teaches year-round competitive swimming. Each summer the EBAT Swim Team, using some of their most accomplished competitive swimmers as instructors, run an eight week learn-to-swim program to teach swimmers & non swimmers how to swim safely, properly, and with confidence. Students are continuously assessed and challenged with a progressive set of skills appropriate for their current level. Our program offers 10 stations from beginners to advanced. The EBAT Learn To Swim program also sets a progressive path to becoming a competitive swimmer. Swim practices immediately follow our learn-to-swim program, so new swimmers and families can stick around after swim lessons to watch a swim practice. If a swimmer is interested in competitive swimming following lessons, we try to make the transition very easy and manageable.

- ~ As swimmers reach the ability to swim independently and the instructor is able to "coach" outside of the water, the class size may increase to as many as 5-8 swimmers to one instructor.
