Travel support will not be provided for a meet that is not sanctioned. It is expected that Clubs send the request for club athletes.

OPEN WATER MEETS

Swimmers finishing in the top eight (8) at the USA Swimming National Open Water Championship will be automatically eligible for Level 1 even if the swimmer does not meet the qualifying time standard in the pool distances cited above. Swimmers selected for the National OW team are also automatically awarded at the Level 1 standard.
