## **MEET RULES:**

- a) Open to all athletes whose schools are members of BCIAA
- b) 2024-2025 National Federation Rules in effect.
- c) No limit on number of team entries per event.
- d) Divers will perform an 11-dive format with no cuts.
- e) No qualifying times for swimming events, except 500 free (6:45 girls; 6:30 boys) *Entry times must have been conducted in a PIAA HS meet.*
- f) Each team is required to supply 2 timers for each session. Please submit those names with contact phone numbers to Roy Snyder at **swimroy@aol.com**

### **ENTRY FEES:**

- a) \$4.00 per individual and \$16.00 per relay
- b) NON-Swim Schools will pay \$20 per athlete
- c) Checks made payable to "BCIAA"
- d) Entry fee should be hand delivered to the meet or mailed in advance to Kerry Ciatto 1008 Hilldale Ct, Reading, PA 19605

## **DIVING ENTRIES**

- a) Diving entry deadline is 5:00 pm on Wednesday, January 29, 2025.
- b) Email dive lists with voluntary dives marked, with name, school, and grade to Kathy Good (kgood916@comcast.net)
- c) PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR DIVERS ARE ALSO INCLUDED IN WITH YOUR SWIMMING ENTRY FILES SWIMMING ENTRIES
  - a) All Entries are due Monday February 3, 2025 by 9:30AM.
  - b) THIS MEET WILL BE USA OBSERVED. Please make sure that all athletes that would like their swim USA OBSERVED have their most updated USA number listed in your TM entry file. (Note- USA swimming changed ALL USA membership numbers this year!)
  - c) To help prepare for the new entry procedures for the PIAA District 3 meet, we will also be <u>USING</u> <u>SWIMCLOUD</u> for entries for the BCIAA MEET. Entry Instructions are below
  - d) A psych sheet will be emailed out as soon as all entries are received and will be posted on the league website.
  - e) No events will be reseeded after this time Any event changes or additions will be placed into empty lanes if available.

### **HEAT SHEETS on MEET MOBILE**

- a) Full results will be available on Meet Mobile.
- b) Heat sheets will be emailed out to all the coaches to be shared with your team's athletes and parents. **NO HEAT SHEETS WILL BE SOLD AT THE EVENT.**

### **AWARDS:**

- a) Specially designed awards will be presented to the top eight finishers in all events.
- b) There will be no team scoring.

# **2025 BCIAA Championship Meet Entry Instructions**

This is a step-by-step guide to complete your team's 2025 BCIAA Championship swim meet entries on Swimcloud.

For additional help, <u>REFERENCE THE GUIDED STEPS PROVIDED IN THE DISTRICT 3 MEET ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS</u>

1 - Make sure you have a Swimcloud Coaching Profile

## 1a - Register as a coach on Swimcloud

You must be a registered coach on Swimcloud to manage your team, roster, and submit entries. **Swimcloud customer service policy requires that we verify a coach's identity and association with a team.** This is very important because Swimcloud takes data integrity and security very seriously.

1b - If you already have a Swimcloud coach account, verify your ability to log in If you have forgotten your
password, you can reset it yourself. Or, you can always reach out to support@swimcloud.com for additional
help.

### 2 - Open the meet on Swimcloud

All BCIAA teams have been pre-assigned to their meet on Swimcloud. This means that the BCIAA meet your team is assigned to will appear in your Swimcloud meet schedule.

## 3 - Upload your entry file to Swimcloud

Swimcloud accepts Hy-Tek Team Manager or Team Unify entry files. Instead of emailing an entry file, you will upload your entry file to Swimcloud.



## 4 - Review, edit, print, and submit entries on Swimcloud

Once your entry file is uploaded to Swimcloud, you can review, edit, print, and even upload a new one.

When your entries are complete in Swimcloud, please be sure to "Submit" them. Clicking submit will generate an email from Swimcloud that contains an entry report and proof that you submitted your entries.

Error Message "Entry time not verified in Swimcloud"



If you do, you will notice an error like this above. This is just a warning to you and the meet admin that the seed time for this entry doesn't conform to the qualifying standards for the meet. You can hover your mouse over the message to get more details. **The entry will still be in the system and will be accepted**.

### 5 - Other Considerations

### **Relay Seed Times Not In Swimcloud**

Coaches manually submit relay times for their "extra" relays that are not in swimcloud. A relay times can NOT be faster than relay times listed in Swimcloud.

## **Non-Swim Schools**

Students from a "non-swim school" that achieve and NOT in Swimcloud, must proof that their entry times were conducted in a PIAA meet and emailed to <a href="https://doi.org/no.com/before-wilsonsd.org">houtho@share.wilsonsd.org</a> before the start of the meet. Individuals entered must have a coach. As stated on Page 33 in the PIAA Handbook - Section 1, Constitution and Bylaws, they must have clearances and other coaching paperwork requirements. Paper work must be shown to Roy Snyder or Tom Houck at the meet. Any athletes without a coach will have to be scratched.
