- A. Finance Report/Budget Review T. Malecki
 - a. Pandemic effects
 - i. Registration and meet rebates
 - ii. Registration reset June 1 down about \$8-10,000 mostly in athletes
 - iii. Meet rebates \$60,000 less for 2020. Includes summer championship meets
