#### **FINANCE**

## A. Finance Report-- T. Malecki

Middle Atlantic had 14 clubs receive awards in the USA Swimming COVID 19 relief program. One club submitted but did not get one. They plan to resubmit. One club submitted but did not tell us about it.

Middle Atlantic matched the grants. We sent out \$65000 in matching funds.

For our PPP loan we should get 100% converted to a grant based on new rules from last week.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### A. Update to Board of Directors reopening efforts—J. Platt

Jamie reported that Middle Atlantic has worked on national exposure, relations and engagement. We have seen LSC's work together on reopening procedures. MA, NJ and AM were on Fox and Middle Atlantic Swimming advocates the growth and development of a diverse swimming community through education, innovation and a commitment to excellence.

Friends in part explaining the importance of opening the swimming world. They gave the national message and the fact that in this area our sport matters.

A letter was sent to the tri-state governors giving them our version of swimming.

Worked with the NJ coaches to help get NJ Swimming open

Sent a letter to a NJ Senator

Talked to parents

We have explained Middle Atlantic, worked on engaging our clubs and offered matching grants to clubs for relief.

The entire board as well as staff were engaged in the efforts.

This tested MA as a whole and everyone stepped up to help when asked. We are advocates for our sport.

Wednesday June 10 MA will hold a Town Hall meeting virtually. 160 people have signed up as of Monday June 8.

#### **B.** Trademark—L. Schwarz

Three-fourths of the way done with the document needed to send to lawyer. Will proceed with TM application. We are seeking to TM only our name not the logo at this time.

#### C. Outreach Program—J. Platt

Coming out of the COVID 19 crisis we anticipate being in a situation dealing with an increase in members undergoing financial struggle. Jamie talked to Larry and Tom about a more comprehensive outreach program that will have greater impact for those in need. Suggests creating a standing outreach committee, which will require a by-law change. Middle Atlantic already has a collaboration with Toad Hollow that could be used to help with cost of equipment. Jamie looking for board support.

The outreach committee would be a separate committee from Diversity/Inclusion.

The goal would be to grow the base, expanding our numbers, by reaching out to those that feel swimming is out of reach financially.

The program can be used to prevent losing members due to the pandemic that may never return.

The program can also be used to help bring in those not yet involved with swimming.

This will make MA more approachable to athletes and families, giving the message we care about you in good times and in bad.

Does this fall within our mission? Some clubs have funds allocated to outreach athletes and this can help them to expand the numbers they help.

Would we require this to be done through the Club?

The new committee would figure out the procedures and how to roll out the program.

A motion was made to amend the by-laws to create a standing outreach committee. Motion passed

### Safe Sport report

At a May 30 virtual conference. USA Swimming announced they will be giving a grant to clubs that complete the Safe Sport Club Recognition program. The first 1500 clubs that complete the program after USA Swimming makes the announcement will receive \$500. Kate proposes Middle Atlantic match the \$500 and to grandfather in the ones that already completed the program prior to USA Swimming announcing the \$500. We have 6 clubs that have completed the program already.

Kate feels we should make this a permanent award for completing the Safe Sport program. If USA Swimming makes it a mandatory requirement, we can revisit the process. If all clubs participate, it will be over \$75,000 in matching funds. If we match the awards for our clubs that are in the first 1500 nationally to complete the program and can add on if this is exceeded.

A motion was made to match grant money provided by USA Swimming for clubs receiving safe sport recognition and to grandfather in the clubs that have already completed the program.

Will have to amend or revisit if we have clubs that achieve the recondition after the first 1500. Motion passes.

Safe Sport report is approved as amended.
