CAMPS: Nothing to report

OPEN WATER: *Chris Barry, Chair*

First, thank you to NJ Swimming for including in the 2022-23 budget funds to participate as a co-host with the Metro LSC for the joint Metro/NJ Open Water Championship on September 24, 2022. The meet was hosted at Rye Beach in New York on the Long Island sound. While the Open Water meet was presented with obstacles, including the late sanctioning, the meet was well organized, run professionally and received positive feedback from those that attending as participants, volunteers, or spectators. Due to some of the issues, entries were less than desired but an increase to 110 from 84 in the prior year (11 from NJ in 2022; up from 4 in 2021). We also had six NJ officials assist at the meet including participating in the two-part USA Swimming training held prior to the meet and required for certification. Some highlights were that Steve Baytin was 4th overall of all swimmers 14 and under in the 1K; Sabine Ristad was 7th overall of all swimmers in the 3K and Alexandra Somers, Ellie De Keukelaere and Madison Benefield were 6th, 7th, and 8th, respectively, overall, of all swimmers in the 5K.

During the past summer, there were also other meets hosted by Metro and Middle Atlantic that attracting swimmers from NJ. I am looking forward to continuing to work with Metro and Middle Atlantic (and any other surrounding LSCs) to seek opportunities for NJ swimmers, including the 2023 Eastern Zone Open Water Championship at Beasley Point in Marmora, NJ (June 24, 2023) and with NJ Swimming approval, to co-host again an LSC Championship with Metro in September 2023.

As previously mentioned, efforts over the past year have been to increase the awareness as well as knowledge of other NJ members through multiple Open Water clinics held this past summer and encouraging others to attend the Eastern Zone Open Water meet in Middlebury, Ct in June 2022 as well as other sanctioned meets held by Metro Swimming. During the 2022-23 short course season, will look to collaborate with other officials that attending meets this past summer to further raise awareness and interest in Open Water swimming while continuing to seek opportunities to develop interest within NJ for Open Water without a large financial commitment.
