Consent Agenda

- Time Standards for Long Course.
 - Shared draft of time standards—Explained how they were derived. The Gold standard is based on the top 60 from all championship meets. The silver standard is based on the top 120 from all championship meets.
 - They are attached—THEY ARE A DRAFT
- Short Course Wrap up- Survey information-
 - Received 15 responses. The main issues were:
 - Not understanding the Lower Silver/Upper Silver cuts—which will not be an issue next year.
 - No announcing of results at Rutgers' 13& Over Jos
 - The fact that scores from both 13 & Over meets were not combined.
 - People also felt that there should have been more heats at finals. A,B,C heats for the 13& Overs and that there should have been finals for the 11-12 Swimmers.
- Long Course Championships:
 - Silver Bronze- July 15-17 (Bids currently in-BB & HACY)—Draft meet announcement attached
 - Junior Olympics- July 29-31
 - No hosts for Eastern Zone meets- both Age Group and Senior yet- according to the Eastern zone website- if there is a host the meets will be August 4-7.
- New Business:
 - Jon Siegel brought up the need to increase entry fees. He is going to write a proposal for the next meeting.
 - Eric Harse brought up the need for scoring to change at the championship meets—to address the way medals are awarded. He felt that there was an issue with the fact that swimmers who were entered as a bronze swimmer and got a gold cut at Silver/Bronze should have been able to get an award.
 - No spectators at meets was brought up. We all agreed that we prefer it. Jon is going to write up a suggested policy for keeping it no spectators at meets.
