#### **Niagara Meet Descriptions**

Niagara LSC Single Age PowerPoint Qualifier Meet: This meet is essentially a combination of the old "Bronze" and "Silver" Single age meet. The format will be a simplified Timed Final format for all swimmers at this level. There will be 2 sets of awards given for the top 8 in each event/single age category. 1 set for Silvers time standards and 1 for Bronze. There will only be a MAXIMUM (slower than) qualifying standards, which will be equal to the Niagara GOLD times (primarily "A" times on the 2009-12 motivational Charts). Up to 2 hosts in different geographic areas.

Niagara LSC 14 & under Single-Age PowerPoint Championships: This meet will be run in a similar fashion to the meet in December of 2008. Multi-age prelims, single-age finals, with the potential for a few POWER events using the multi-gender format (TBD later by Technical Planning). High emphasis on awards and recognition at the finals and his meet is intended to have a "different" feel and format from all the other LSC meets. Single meet host.

<u>Niagara LSC "BB" (silver) Qualifier Meet</u>: This meet will be identical in format to the traditional "Bronze" District meet in all except the name. MAXIMUM (slower than) qualifying standards equal to the "silver" times ("BB" on the 2009-12 motivational Charts). Timed final 4 session meet Up to 3 hosts in different geographic areas.

<u>Niagara LSC Go the Distance Meet</u>: This 12 & under meet, which for the last several years was coupled with the above senior champs and is recommended to be done that way again this year. Same meet format (2 session, timed final) in place for an evening and than morning session.

Niagara LSC Senior Single-Age PowerPoint Championships: This meet will be identical in format and design as has been done the last few years. 3 session, timed final meet with alternative awards (bell ringer). Potential exists for Power events as well. High emphasis on speed for this meet and an Olympian will be brought in by the host as has been done in the past. Single meet host and recommended to be the same as the Go the distance meet. Qualifying times are equal to 13-14 "A" (gold) Standards.

<u>Niagara LSC Championships Qualifier Meet</u>: This meet will be identical in format to the traditional "Silver" District meet in all except the name. MAXIMUM (slower than) qualifying standards equal to the "gold" times. MINIMUM (faster than) qualifying standards equal the "silver" times ("BB" on the 2009-12 motivational Charts). Prelims/Final format in place and the same event list as the Championship meet. Up to 2 hosts in different geographic areas.

<u>Niagara LSC Championships</u>: This meet will be the championships for the LSC, with an emphasis on performance. 7 Session meet with a minimum of 8-10 lanes in 1-2 courses required (same as past years). This meet will have a MINIMUM (faster than) standards meet, with the minimum cut times equaling the applicable Gold level (Age Group) times.
