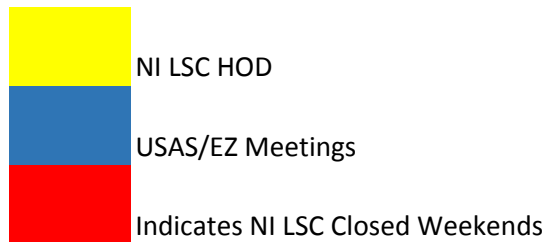

The Annual Spring Meeting of the Eastern Zone will be held in **Virginia Beach** on **Saturday, May 9th**. The tentative meeting schedule is as follows:

We have reserved a block of rooms at the Crowne Plaza, Virginia Beach Town Center and all meetings will be held at this location. The room rate is \$129 plus tax per night but because there is a large group in the area that weekend, all hotels in the area have imposed a two-night minimum stay. All rooms must be guaranteed with a major credit card or one night's deposit. You can make reservations by calling 1-800-277-6963 or 1-800-2CROWNE. Be certain to specify that you are part of the **East Zone Spring Meeting – Swim Team** when making reservations. The final date for making reservations is **Wednesday, April 8th**. After that date the remaining rooms will be released. Any reservations must be **cancelled 72 hours prior to arrival** to avoid charges. The room rate of \$129 will be available three days prior and three days following the meeting should anyone choose to extend his/her stay.

The registration fee for the meeting is the same as in previous years:

2015 EZ Diversity Swim Summit

About the USA Swimming 2015 Eastern Zone Diversity Summit

The Eastern Zone will host our 3rd ever Diversity Select Summit in an effort to identify the emerging young diverse athletes from under-represented populations in the sport, LSC Chairs and Coaches from each LSC and offer them a unique motivational and educational experience. Participants from the various LSCs that comprise of the Eastern Zone would participate in a three-day program, which includes pool training, motivational, and education sessions and team-building activities.

Purpose:

Celebrate the opportunities of/for diversity in swimming in the Eastern Zone through inspiration of athletes, coaches and volunteers. Create local ambassadors and leaders to grow our sport.

Goals:

Empower athletes from ethnically under represented populations and their coaches to:

- Demonstrate the viability of multicultural success in swimming within their local LSC
- Achieve performance excellence throughout the sport
- Introduce the benefits and value of participating in the sport of swimming
- Develop positive leaders and role models that others from multicultural backgrounds can emulate
- Connect, network and promote the virtues of the sport of swimming through a comprehensive strategy involving the athletes, coaches and LSC Diversity Chairs in their own local LSCs and throughout the Eastern Zone.

Attendees: Approximately 30-35 athletes (15+ boys / 15+ girls) ages 13-16 years olds (male and female from each zone) along with Coaches and LSC Diversity Chairs are invited to attend.

Dates and Location: at the **University of Maryland** and neighboring facilities. Athletes, coaches and volunteers will be housed in us dorms. We will have Long Course sessions and Short Course sessions for the **June 25 – 28th** swimmer participants. Meals will be catered on-site by the school or by a local national catering company. Athletes will arrive Thursday (June 25) late afternoon/ evening and depart Sunday (June 28rd) morning.

Invitees:

- 2 athletes from each of the 12 LSCs in the Eastern Zone
- 1 Diversity Coordinator and/or Coach from each LSC

Attendance Notification Deadline:

Applications must be postmarked by **May 1, 2015** Participating LSCs must submit a list of attending athletes, coach and Diversity Chair to the oversight committee at:

Funding: Each LSC will fund two athletes, the Diversity Chair and/or Coach to the summit. Funding will need to include transportation to and from the summit, and an additional fee of **\$300** (approximate) per person will cover housing and all meal costs. This is based on two - person occupancy in each room, if the coach or Diversity Chair wishes a single occupancy room, an additional cost per night will be incurred by the LSC.

Qualifications: Athletes must have qualified in at least one individual event in their local LSC championship meet in either SCY or LC seasons. It is up to the Diversity Chair and/or Coach to select the exact criteria based on his/her LSC. In the event that there are no qualifying swimmers, the LSC can elect to send two athletes of its choice.

Selection: Each LSC will select the two athletes they wish to represent that LSC using the application provided. The LSC has the option to select one coach based on their own LSC evaluation to participate in the summit.

Schedule: The three day program will include a combination of pool training, motivational and educational sessions, networking and strategic planning sessions for members of each LSC, and team building activities.

Coaches & Diversity Chairs: The the Diversity Chair and/or Coach track will include observing in-water workouts, classroom sessions with guest speakers and strategic planning sessions and goal setting with their LSC specific participants and athletes. These participants do not need to arrive until **Friday June 26st** by noon.

Staff: The staff will be selected from accomplished multicultural candidates from the Eastern Zone and other regions across the United States. The staff will include a head coach, two assistant coaches, a camp manager and a national athlete along with the oversight committee. USA Swimming will make the selections for all staff at the camp. LSC Coach Mentoring Grant Program

Purpose: Create a coach mentoring program for club coaches in the LSCs.

Many successful coaches talk about how they were mentored earlier in their career. This program is intended to create a practical and affordable means to connect younger inexperienced coaches with a veteran coach to aid in the development and education of the coach.

Funding: \$40,000 for the pilot program in 2015

This program is to be jointly funded between USA Swimming and an LSC. The LSC can apply for a grant of up to \$4,000. The LSC must support the program with a matching amount equal to a minimum of 50% of the money requested from USA Swimming. (Example: if requesting \$4,000 from USA Swimming the LSC must match with a minimum amount of \$2,000). Preference will be given to LSCs that support the program with an even matching amount. Depending on the number of LSCs that apply, USA Swimming may attempt to spread the funding available to more LSCs.

Preference is given to disbursing the grant from USA Swimming to the LSC in one payment at the end of the year upon timely submittal of the appropriate paperwork. However, an LSC may request 50% of the grant money be disbursed to the LSC at the beginning of the program. LSCs will be required to submit an accounting of any expenses that they paid out to coaches/clubs prior to receiving the final payment from USA Swimming.

Each LSC shall come up with their own criteria of how the program is to be administered.

Some suggestions for an LSC to consider in administration of the program:

1. A minimum visit of ½ day with a maximum of 3 days (2 nights)
2. An LSC may want to partner with an adjoining LSC to run the program

3. Each LSC is to come up with their own list of mentor coaches. Possible suggestions might be finding coaches who are good at:
 - a. Working with novice, entry-level athletes
 - b. Good dryland program
 - c. Running a learn-to-swim program
 - d. Writing workouts for senior level athletes
 - e. Season planning
 - f. Managing a satellite program
 - g. Coaching advanced age group athletes
 - h. Recruiting new swimmers
 - i. Running the business side of the club
 - j. Moving athletes from Sectionals to Junior Nationals
 - k. Technical skills (teaching specific swimming skills)
 - l. How to become a good head age group coach
 - m. Developing a progressive age group program
 - n. How to make age group practices exciting and fun
 - o. How to help a swimmer with college recruiting
4. Reimbursement to the mentored coach will include actual expenses incurred such as mileage (LSC to determine rate) or transportation, hotel, food or per diem. Mentored coach is to submit the original receipts for reimbursement to the LSC. A meal(s) for the mentor coach could also be submitted if the mentor coach and mentored coach dined together. The LSC may want to impose a limit to how much could be submitted for a meal.
5. Upon completion of the visit, the mentored coach is to submit a report to the LSC outlining what they learned from the visit.
6. The mentor coach is also to complete a short survey.
7. The LSC may establish a small honorarium for the mentor coach. Suggestions might be an actual honorarium or a gift card/restaurant card.
8. To activate the program a coach would fill out a visit request form within the LSC and submit to the appropriate person (could be the coach's rep, permanent office, senior chair, etc...).
9. Upon approval the mentoree would then make the arrangements with the mentor coach for the visit.
10. Coaches that are eligible for USA Swimming's National Junior Team visit program would be ineligible to participate as a mentoree.

Additional items for an LSC to consider when designing the program:

- Set up or describe what is required of the mentor coaches
- Frequently asked questions
- Some type of follow up documentation
- How the goals of the program are communicated?
- Encourage ongoing communication between mentor and mentoree
- Is there some type of contribution from the mentored coach's club?
- Does there need to be some type of sign-off from the mentoring and mentored club?
