Time Standards:

- Analyzed the 2018 times verse the 2019 winter standards
- 15+ girls heavy looked at what is a good size number of participates per event
- 50 for cuts as a base
- By making some events faster you force them to try other events
- College kids in events which makes the 15+ heavier
- What were the original standards designed to do? Have a certain about in prelims so that 2 heats make finals
- Motion to shoot for 40 people per event,
 - 15+ is more age groups should get more

Meet Announcement:

- July 1, 2017 cut off for times
- Awards: Medals 1-8 individual, medals 1-3 for relays
- Top 3 teams overall
- Top small team
- Session length:
 - Sessions are 5 hours too long
 - Go to 6 maximum events not 7

Vote: changing max events to 6 instead of 7- all voted in favor

- Relays:
 - Currently age group relays
 - 3 options
 - 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & Over
 - 10 & Under, 11-14, 15 & Over
 - 14 & Under, 15 & Over
 - 2 Relay only swimmers, no qualifying
 - 10 & Under relays mixed, girls or boys- do not score differently time standards are the same

Vote: Relay structure

10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & Over- NO

10 & Under, 11-14, 15 & Over- All yes

Events:

- Move the 800 free relay to Thursday

- 400 Medley relay moved to Friday for everyone except for the 10 & Under
- Remove the 400 Medley and 400 Free Relay for 10 & Under
- 200 Medley relays moved to Saturday for all 3 age groups, 200 Free relay everyone minus 10 & Under- sandwich session, start and end the session with relays
- Sunday 200 Free relay for 10 & Under only, 400 free relay for 11 & Up ages

No one opposed to event changes

Put in meet announcement that it must be an observed meet to qualify

Bid Calendar-

Niagara reimbursement policy
