"SAFE SPORT CLUB COORDINATOR"

Charge: The purpose of the Safe Sport Club Coordinator is to identify, plan, and execute efforts to raise awareness for Safe Sport within the Club's Coaches, Parents, Athletes, and Officials.

Requirements:

- 1. Be a registered Non-Athlete Member of USA Swimming.
- 2. Successfully pass the required USA Swimming Criminal Background Check.
- 3. Complete the USA Swimming Athlete Protection Training.
- 4. Attend an LSC Safe Sport Club Coordinator Educational Session in the first year, then annually or as recommended by the LSC Safe Sport Chair.

Selection and Term of Service: Shall be dictated by each Member Club.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Serve on Club Board of Directors Reports to the Club President or Owner, and LSC Safe Sport Chair.
- 2. Be a resource for the club on how to create and foster positive Safe Sport culture.
- 3. Work with Club Leadership to:
 - a. Update Club Safe Sport website content on Clubs Team Unify Website.
 - b. Include Safe Sport information or fliers in Club meet information, heat sheets, meet packets.
 - c. Coordinate the successful completion of the Safe Sport Certified Club application.
- 4. Works with new Athletes and Parents to:
 - a. Educate them about MAAPP and the Safe Sport Program.
 - b. Encourage participation in all Athlete Protection Education Programs on the Learn Platform.
- 5. Organize In-Person Training:
 - a. Secure the session trainer.
 - b. Coordinate logistics for club members: date, time, location, also any refreshments or other items required to conduct the training.
- 6. Solicit and receive feedback and suggestions on the Safe Sport policies and programs from the Club's Membership, and provide Monthly Feedback to the LSC Safe Sport Chair.
