<u>**Camera Zones:**</u> per Florida Swimming Rule 223.13, Meet Management shall designate and inform the public of "Camera Zones" at each swim meet where both still photography and video photography of a race or a competitor in a race may be taken. Acceptable "Camera Zones" may include, but not limited to the side courses of a pool, team gathering areas, concession area, turn-end of competition course when not in use as a "start-end", etc.. Meet management shall also designate "Non-Camera Zones". Under NO circumstances will Camera Zones include the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) while they are in use for "racing starting purposes" during competition and warm-ups, locker rooms, restrooms, or any other dressing area. Any individual failing to abide by this rule could be subject to the Florida Swimming Coda of Conduct violation as defined in Rule 239.2

## **Condition of Approval:**

The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA-S coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the Swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue pools, athlete/coach areas. Spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
