# IM Xtreme Challenge at Plantation, May 14-16

In our only meet of May we swam our second Long Course Meet of the season. It was in a very different format, IMX Challenge format. IMX is a program created by USA Swimming to challenge our age group swimmers to swim 100's and 200's of stroke per age group. There were no 50's offered in any age group so all of our swimmers swam in events they otherwise wouldn't have swam. I am very proud of our swimmers for swimming out of the comfort zone and doing a terrific job.

Rachel Blieden swam in her first long course meet of the season dropping 9 seconds in her 100 Breast, dropping another 11 seconds in her 200 IM, and dropping 15 seconds in the 200 Free, way to go!

Bobby Hart dropped over 5 seconds in the 100 Breast and swam the 200 IM for the first time.

Eden Lenner dropped 22 seconds in the 100 Breast and also swam the 200 IM for the first time, and somehow got out of swimming the 400 Free, Only Eden gets this lucky lol.

Jake Lieberfarb dropped over 25 seconds in the 100 Breast and swam the 200 IM, 400 Free, 100 Back and 100 Fly all for the first time. Way to STEP UP JAKE!!!


