District Championship Recap

This was one of the most exciting District Meets I have been a part of! We faced Saint Andrew's twice this year, losing to them at both the Palm League Championships and in a home dual meet. Going into Districts, which were held at Saint Andrew's on their home turf, we knew it would be difficult — if not a long shot. We emphasized the importance of *every point and every race*, with the top 16 swimmers and divers scoring in each event.

We knew the results would come down to everyone contributing — even if it was just one or two points — and in the end, that's exactly what made the difference. Those few points secured our 2025 FHSAA District Championships!

- Girls defeated Saint Andrew's by 12.5 points, 505–492.5
- **Boys** won by the same margin, 497.5–485

It was a magical night, and we as coaches could not be prouder of this group.
