SWIM FLORIDA COACHES RULE AND PROCEDURES

These the guidelines that Swim Florida Coaches should follow at practice as well at meets. We need as a coach to show professionalism at all times.

- 1. Coaches must maintain a neat appearance.
- 2. Coaches must inform parents of the practice times especially the outlining pools.
- 3. Coaches must be on time for practice or notify a parent if running late so that parent can inform others parents as they wait. (especially outlining pools).
- 4. Coaches should inform parents if practice is canceled (example like attending a meet).
- 5. Coaches should communicate with swimmers about anti- bullying and they should respect the other swimmers. And tell swimmers to tell you if any acts of bullying are happening. So you can address the swimmer doing the bullying.
- 6. Coaches should inform Parents on how meets are done and how to sign up for their child and to visit the website for up coming events. And contact by email to SwimFlorida @aol.com on any questions.
- 7. Coaches are encourage to keep practices fun. (especially the novice swimmers)
- 8. Coaches should check meet entries before the deadline. And encourage parents to sign up early or help them get their swimmers in the meet.
- 9. Coaches are to help at home or away meets with warms ups and relays.
- 10. Coaches are to inform their swimmers of relays and should encourage them to do the relays.
- 11. Coach must stay at their facilities until all swimmers are picked up after practices. Also inform their parents to contact you if running late for pickup.
