

## COMPETITION CODE OF CONDUCT

## **General Swim Meet Policies**

- 1. No swimmer shall attend a meet unless accompanied by a parent or a chaperone arranged for the by the swimmer's parents.
- 2. No swimmer drive a car to, form, an away meet unless accompanied by a parent or chaperone. Swimmers 19 years of age and older may drive themselves, but may not accompanied by younger swimmers.
- 3. Meet warm-ups times; which are set by the staff and published in the team meet information on the team website; are to be strictly adhered to by all team members unless your coach tells you different. Or you have talk to your coach 3 days before going to the meet.
- 4. In general, team members should check with the coaches prior to leaving a meet. Should it become necessary for a swimmer to leave a meet early, his/her and after each of their events.
- 5. Swimmers are expected to meet with their coach before and after each of their events.
- 6. In a prelim & final meets. all swimmers who qualify to compete in the finals are expected to participate in the finals. All teams members are strongly encourage to return to the finals sessions to support the team and take advantage of the opportunity to learn from watching the finals. At times, alternates and relays positions open up that need to be filled.
- 7. All team members are expected to follow the team uniform policy. Be proud to wear your red or white shirts. Your personal appearance shall be neat and appropriate at all times.
- 8. Swimmers are expected to sit with the team and participate in all team meet activities and team meetings.
- 9. Team members and parents are expected to display proper respect and sportsmanship toward coaches, officials,, meet administrators and fellow competitors.
- 10. As a matter of team pride and courtesy to the meet host, swimmers and expected to leave the MAC team area in a neat and clean condition at the conclusion of each session of the meet.
- 11. All questions swimmers or parents may have concerning meet results, an officiating call, or the conduct of a meet, should be referred to the SWIM coaching staff only, Our coaches, in turn, will peruse the matter through appropriate.
- 12 In the accordance with USA Swimming rules, parents are expected to remain in the designated spectator area, unless they are working the meet in an official capacity.
