



2019 – 07 July ATAC Boosters Meeting Minutes

Called to order at 5:30 PM by President Traci Campbell

Report from Coach Terry

- Reviewed meet schedule for Fall 2019
 - Coach Terry will forward changes to Frances and publish as soon as possible
 - Jamye Wars will load meets onto the ATAC Website
 - Traci Campbell will add Team Hotel information to the Meet Information pages on the website once they are loaded

Stroke and Turn Clinic

- Scheduled for July 23 at 5:15 PM at Myers Park prior to Summer League Meet #5
- Great way for new parents to learn about stroke techniques and how to view the swims from the eyes of the officials
- This clinic is the first step in becoming certified as an Official
- ATAC is in critical need of more parents to become trained as Officials

USA Swimming MAAPP Compliance

- Jennifer Koslow reported that we are down to 60 parents (from 500) still needing to sign the MAAPP Acknowledgement forms. Way to go Jen!
- She will continue to work with France and Coach Amanda to personally contact the remaining parents to have the forms signed

By Laws Committee

- Final version has been approved by the committee (clean up of the “Membership Eligibility” language)
- By Laws will now be passed on to the City of Tallahassee for approval

Nominations Committee

- Michele Anderson was removed from the committee (by her request) and Karen Unger was added to the committee
- Traci Campbell to send email to ATAC members requesting submission of names to the committee members for the Executive Board positions
- Nominating Committee will verify that people who are nominated actually want to run for the positions they are nominated for
- Elections for each Executive Board position will be held at the General ATAC Membership Meeting to be held in August (date TBD)

Fundraising

- Nothing formal is planned regarding fundraising at this point beyond our normal activities (meets and store sales)
- Jennifer Koslow and Traci Campbell will look into details of a Swim-A-Thon through USA Swimming. Coach Terry was in favor of doing a Swim-A-Thon as long as it was worked around big meet training schedules

Area 1 & 4 Championship Meet

- Spirit Party
 - Party will be held on THURSDAY August 1 at 6 PM.
 - Order of events is Team Photos (in white shirts Age Group, Novice), Awards (medals for Bronze, Silver, Gold, including Summer League and Year Round swimmers), and Dinner. Activity Pool will open at 7 PM until 8 PM.
 - Ginny Barber and Deana Bell will coordinate getting food (pizza, bananas, cookies and small waters) for the party
 - Ginny Barber will coordinate with her contact about taking the team photo
- Meet Management
 - Shanin Frost (Meet Manager) confirmed that registrations and files have been sent out to the Area 1 & 4 teams
 - Deadline for ATAC Registration – Sunday July 21
 - Deadline for Visiting Teams Registration – Monday July 22
 - Email will be sent to Visiting Teams about T-Shirt pre-orders, available coupons, and general information about the meet (Shanin to send)
 - Shanin will provide Karen Unger the heat sheets no later than July 24
- Vendors
 - Total Teamwares will be on site for the meet – Coach Terry coordinating
 - Lucky Goat checking on bus availability for the meet
- Concessions and Hospitality
 - Ice has been ordered
 - Karoline Hodge to provide Traci Campbell with list of food items for donations for the website
 - Breakfast only will be provided in the Hospitality room due to the meet ending each morning prior to lunch time
- Awards and T-Shirts
 - Trophies are being awarded to High Point Visiting Team and Runner Up
 - High Point awards for swimmers are Medal Holders and Tumblers
 - Meet T-Shirts are available for Pre-Order
 - ATAC Championship Shirt will be given to each swimmer who registers for the meet. Coach Amanda will continue to push registration for the meet mentioning this as an incentive.
 - Nicole must have all names of swimmers by July 25th in order to get the ATAC Championship shirt orders placed.

Summer League Meets

- Coach Amanda reported they have gone very well this summer
- Generally there have been around 80 swimmers registered for each meet
- For the last meet (Meet #5), we will encourage the swimmers to sit together, by age group, under tents set up behind the coaches.
- We will encourage the new parents to time for the meet since their swimmers will all be sitting together.
- Our swimmer volunteers will help wrangle the kids and get them where they need to be (and still get service hours)
