Coaches Report

Rep Updates

President Ralys shared on behalf of the Age Group and Novice reps updates. Seniors had a Thanksgiving gathering and planned to do a white elephant exchange. Pre senior group also plans the same for the white elephant exchange.

Treasurer Report

Treasurer Autry reports for the past month, the Boosters Income totaled \$4,057.94 and incurred \$1,424.50 in cost of goods sold (Team T-shirts) for a Gross Profit of \$2,651.44. Notable income during this period was related to meet entry fees collected (Gator Invitational), merchandise sales (towels) and meet sponsorships (2022 and 2023 Mac Meet and 2022 Area 1&4). For the past month, the Boosters incurred Expenses totaling \$4,048.21. Notable expenditures during this period were for awards and prizes (Summer Championship shirts), meet entry fees (Gator Invitational), and coaches travel to out-of-town meets (High School State, and Dothan Invitational). For the period between 11/9/2022 and 12/6/2022, the Boosters had Operating Income of -\$1,396.77. The Boosters account has a current balance of \$43,905.04 which puts the Boosters in a sound financial position as we continue into the Fall/Winter season.
