



## **ATAC Booster Meeting**

**Date:** December 16, 2025

**Call to Order Time:** The meeting began at 5:47 PM.

### **Coaches Report:**

Coach John announced that ATAC will partner with FSU's Dance Marathon for the upcoming MAC Meet. ATAC usually donates a percentage of the MAC Meet proceeds to the Mac Crutchfield Foundation, but Maggie Crutchfield has agreed to donate the funds generated this year to Dance Marathon. Riley, past ATAC swimmer and cancer survivor, and Grace, the Dance Marathon Executive Director at FSU, presented. Riley was diagnosed with lymphoma her senior year of high school and is now a part of Dance Marathon. Grace explained that the money that ATAC donates will go to cancer research and FSU's College of Medicine to promote local research.

Coach John explained that the Gator Invitational in Ocala went well. He also explained that Owen Ekk did well at Junior Nationals in Indianapolis. He got 4th in the 400 IM and 5th in the 200 IM. Winter Warrior (novice-presenior) and Survivor (senior) has started and there has been great participation and attendance. The holiday practice schedule has been finalized and will be sent out this week.

### **President Report:**

The Booster President shared that the red & green teams will be announced soon, and caps will be provided on Saturday at the meet. She also provided information about the upcoming MAC and explained that sponsorship information will be sent out soon via email. She explained that we will need volunteers for this event in order to make it a success.

### **Treasurer Report:**

The Booster Treasurer shared that for the month of November 2025, we generated a total income of \$1,697.85. Notable income sources during this period was from annual team fees, meet entry fee income, merchandise sales, and sponsorships. The cost of goods sold totaled \$668.50 and our gross profit was \$1,029.35. The Boosters incurred expenses that totaled \$8,819.90. Notable expenditures during this period were for administrative fees, awards and prizes, meet sanctioning, equipment and pool supplies, coaches travel to away swim meets, and COT pool rental. For the period, the Boosters



generated an operating income of -\$7,790.55, and the checking account balance is currently \$38,713.87.
