



## **ATAC Booster Meeting**

**Date:** February 10, 2026

**Call to Order Time:** The meeting began at 5:45 PM.

### **Coaches Report:**

Coach Terry expressed the need for volunteers to help Coach Eddie in his Meet Manager duties. He suggested that a consistent small group of volunteers needs to be established to help set-up, tear down, and load/unload the trailer for all ATAC meets. Coach Terry and Coach John explained when and why the coaches move swimmers up to the next level group. Typically, moves are made three times a year- beginning of the school year, after spring break, and at the end of the school year. However, space is limited in each group, so the coaches are very intentional when moving a swimmer. They are constantly assessing the swimmers to determine if and when they should be moved. The coaches look at the swimmer's talent-level, attendance, motivation, and teamwork.

Coach Amanda shared that she is working on the summer practice schedule and organizing the coaching staff in preparation for a great summer season. She also explained that all FSU clubs require their members to complete service hours, so she will send our meet schedule to the clubs to generate more volunteers at our home meets.

### **Officials Report:**

Scott Richardson shared that there is an officials shortage, which makes it hard to run and officiate meets well. All meets have to have a specific number of officials, so if we do not recruit more officials, ATAC may not be able to sanction and hold home meets. ATAC will pay the registration and training fees of all parents interested in becoming an official. It is an easy process, and once you complete the training to become certified, you are able to officiate a variety of meets in the state of Florida. If any parents are interested in becoming an official, Scott would be happy to talk to anyone about the process and answer any questions.



### **President Report:**

The Booster President explained that the MAC Meet was a huge success and thanked all of the volunteers and committee members for making the meet great. Volunteers will be needed for the Last Chance Qualifier meet on Feb. 21. She also shared that the Championship Spirit Party (for Area 4, Flags, and Senior Champ swimmers) will be on Feb. 25 at 6:30. Swimmers will receive snack bags and t-shirts at the party. She then shared that the ATAC Banquet will be on March 29 at the FSU Union Ballroom, and a save the date was sent out. More information and banquet tickets will be available soon.
