

ATAC Booster Meeting

Date: November 18, 2025

<u>Call to Order Time</u>: The meeting began at 5:45 PM.

Coaches Report:

Coach Amanda and Coach Jon discussed that the Dothan meet went well with many swimmers making best times. The next meet will be the Gator Invitational in Ocala, which will take place in December. This meet does require swimmers to have qualifying times in order to compete, and the deadline to sign-up for this meet is this Thursday. Winter Warrior will begin on December 1- Novice and Age Group swimmers will be required to attend 70% of practices, and Presenior and Senior swimmers will be required to attend 100% of practices in order to earn the honor. The Red & Green meet is also coming up in December. This meet will consist of 50s and 100lMs in order to keep the length of the meet down. This meet will also have a later start time allowing the sun to come out and keep the swimmers warm. The high school season was great, and the swimmers did well with 70% earning best times. Many of our swimmers went to state championships and earned top finishes.

President Report:

The Booster President shared that the annual pancake breakfast/cap contest and fall invitational were successful. She also provided information about the upcoming MAC and explained that sponsorship information will be sent out soon via email. She explained that we will need volunteers for this event in order to make it a success. Finally, she encouraged parents to volunteer to be a group coordinator for the novice and pre-senior 2 groups, which would be great to build team relationships.

Treasurer Report:

The Booster Treasurer shared that for the month of October 2025, we generated a total income of \$6,538.50. Notable income sources during this period was from annual team fees, meet entry fee income, merchandise sales, and sponsorships. The cost of goods sold totaled \$759.06 and our gross profit was \$5,779.44. The Boosters incurred expenses that totaled \$4,065.96. Notable expenditures during this period were for administrative fees, meet sanctioning and splash fees, coaches travel to away swim meets, and the spirit party. For the period, the Boosters generated an operating income of \$1,713.48, and the checking account balance is currently \$49,516.53. The 2026



proposed budget was also discussed.

Committee & Rep Updates:

Spirit Gear/Swag Chair explained that an email was recently sent out about preordering sweatshirts, towels, and blankets. Orders are due by November 28.
