FACILITY:	Franklin Community High School 2600 Cumberland Drive Franklin, IN 46131 An eight-lane 50-meter pool with seating for 750 spectators; Daktronics timing system with touchpads will be used with two 8 lane readout scoreboards. FRST intends to run the meet in lanes 1-7, using lane 8 for warm-up/warm-down for the Senior session. <u>FRST, however, does reserve the right to change lane configuration based on entries.</u> Swimmer 'camping' will be on deck and in designated areas. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The pool depth ranges from 5'0" to 4'0" feet.

MEET FORMAT:	<p>All 10 & Under events will be timed finals. All 11 & over events will be run as Prelim / Final Championship Format with the exception of the 400 Free, 400 IM, and 1500 Free which will be run as timed finals with the top 7 qualifiers swimming at finals. For prelim/final events, the top 14 from prelims will advance into the consolation and championship finals heats at night for the 11-12, 13-14, and open age groups.</p> <p>National scratch procedures, USA Swimming rule 207.11.6, will be observed. Modifications and additions are noted in the Scratches Section below.</p> <p>Scratching from Consolations, and Finals: Any swimmer qualifying for the original B or A Final in an individual event, or seeded in an individual timed final event, who fails to compete in said final shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet (Additional penalties may apply for the Sunday Evening Session.).</p> <p>FRST reserves the right to limit the number of entries and any event to achieve a 4-hour maximum timeline. No team will be broken if entry limits are applied. The Meet Entry Chair will notify all accepted teams of any limited events and will refund the fees for those events limited or reduced from the original entry.</p>
ELIGIBILITY:	<p>Swimmer(s) must be registered with USA Swimming prior to the competition. Age as of June 21st, 2024 shall determine the swimmer's age for the entire meet (205.2.2).</p>
ENTRY LIMITS:	<p>Each 11&Over swimmer will be limited to three (3) individual events per day and one relay event per day. 10&Under athletes will be limited to four (4) events per day and one relay event per day.</p>
ENTRY FEES:	<p>All entry fees must be paid by Friday, June 21, 2024. Please make check payable to: FRANKLIN REGIONAL SWIM TEAM. Timed finals events are \$5.00 each, prelims/final events are \$6.00 per event. There is also a per swimmer, per meet, Indiana Swimming surcharge which must accompany entry. For athletes registered in Indiana, this is a \$2.50 surcharge. For Out of LSC athletes, this is a \$5.00 surcharge. No refunds will be made on entry fees.</p> <p>Deck entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Director as new additions. CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. The entry fee for deck entries is \$12.00 per prelim/finals event, \$10.00 per timed final event. Fees for deck entries will be expected at the time of the entries in cash or check.</p>
ENTRY DEADLINE:	<p>No entries will be accepted before entries open. Any entries arriving before entries open will not be processed until all entries received during the entry period are processed and the entry deadline has passed. Any entries arriving after the entry deadline will be considered deck entries and are subject to that fee. The deadline may be extended if the meet is not full. All entries must arrive via e-mail. Changes, updates, corrections (including entry times) will be accepted via email until the modification deadline. FRST reserves the right to determine which teams' entries are accepted. FRST Reserves the right to limit the number of</p>

entries in all events to keep the timeline manageable. FRST will try to accommodate all entered teams until the meet is considered at capacity.

Teams Notified of Acceptance: NO LATER THAN Wednesday, June 1st, 2024, 5:00 PM
Entry Modification Deadline: Friday, June 14th, 2024 5:00 PM

SCRATCHES:

The following scratch deadlines will be used throughout the meet:
Friday Events need to be scratched via email to the entry chair by **5:00 PM Thursday, June 20th, 2024**
Saturday Events need to be scratched by **5:00 PM Friday, June 21st, 2024**
Sunday Events need to be scratched by **5:00 PM Saturday, June 22nd, 2024**

For Finals, athletes will have 30 minutes to declare their intent to scratch from the time the results are read by the announcer following the race following which they have until the end of the session to change their intent.

SCRATCH PROCEDURES – INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

National scratch procedures, USA Swimming rule 207.11.6, will be observed. Additions and modifications are noted below:

Preliminary Heats

In all events where preliminary heats are necessary, **or in any timed final event, excluding 10 & Unders**, after the heats have been seeded, any swimmer who fails to compete in an individual event heat in which they are entered and have not been scratched in accordance to the above deadline **will be barred from all further individual events of that day**. (NOTE: This does not bar an individual who has qualified earlier in the session for a Consolation or Final from swimming in that Final.) The application of this penalty shall pertain to the order in which the event/heats are swum, not the numerical order of the events. Additionally, that swimmer shall be scratched from any individual events on succeeding days unless that swimmer or the swimmer's coach declares the swimmer's intent to swim prior to the close of the scratch box for that day's events, or within 30 minutes of the missed event.

A re-entry fee of \$50.00 can be paid to re-enter a session on a positive check-in basis in accordance with Rule 207.11.6.

Scratching from Consolations, and Finals

SUNDAY ONLY: No-shows or not scratching according to the rules by the appropriate deadlines (Exceptions for failure to compete - B), for original/initial consolation finals or finals will result in a \$50 fine per swimmer regardless of the number of events missed that finals session. The fine shall be assessed to the swimmer's team.

A. Any swimmer qualifying for the original consolation final or final in an individual event who fails to compete in said final shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet except as noted in "Exceptions" below. A declared false start 101.1.3E or deliberate delay of meet 101.1.5 is NOT permitted and will be regarded as a failure to compete. In the event of withdrawal or barring of a swimmer from the competition, the Referee shall fill the consolation final or final when possible with the next qualified swimmer(s). Any potential alternate for finals must report to the Deck Referee or Starter prior to the applicable event. There will be no announcements made to fill the heat.

	<p>B. The first and second alternates shall be announced along with the final qualifiers. These alternates shall not be penalized if unavailable to compete in the finals.</p> <p>C. Where consolation finals have not yet been swum and a barring or withdrawal is known to the Referee, the Referee shall re-seed the consolation final and the final, if necessary, to insert the alternate(s) in appropriate lane(s), filling all lanes in the final.</p> <p>D. If the consolation final has already been contested, the final shall be swum without re-seeding for the empty lane(s).</p>
CLERK OF COURSE:	There will be a Clerk of Course for 10 and Under events ONLY. Clerk of Course is located to the Southwest of the competition pool.
AWARDS/SCORING:	<p>Medals will be awards for 1st through 3rd and ribbons for places 4-8th in individual events for 14 & Under swimmers.</p> <p>Age group categories for awards will be 8-under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14. No awards for open events.</p> <p>Points will be awarded for the top 16 places in each event per standard scoring (20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1) for individual events. Relays will be doubled.</p> <p>Coaches should pick up awards at the end of the meet. No awards will be mailed.</p>
WARM-UP:	Lanes for warm-ups will be assigned. All participants must adhere to a complete schedule of lanes and times for all warm-up procedures and will be posted at the facility during the meet.
SCHEDULE:	<p>Our schedule will be somewhat flexible and subject to change based on entries. CONCESSIONS:	<p>Food Trucks or concession stands will be made available to athletes and spectators.</p> <p>A hospitality area will be available for coaches, officials, and volunteers.</p>

ADMISSION:	<p>The following admission options will be available (Children 10 & Under are free): Heat sheets for prelims & Timed Finals Sessions - \$2.00 1 Session Pass (Any single session including Finals) - \$6.00 1 Session Finals Pass (Includes a Heat Sheet) - \$5.00 All Day Pass - \$10.00 (Includes Finals Admission and Finals Heat Sheet) All Weekend Pass - \$20.00. (Includes Finals Admission and Finals Heat Sheet) Heat Sheets will attempt to be made available 10 minutes prior to start of meet in the main atrium</p>
SALES:	<p>Aquatic outfitting vending will be provided by a local vendor, selling items from suits to goggles. FRST also expects multiple other vendors to be available.</p>
PSYCH SHEETS:	<p>Psych sheets will be posted to the meet website by Wednesday at noon prior to the start of the meet. Heat sheets will be available for purchase at the meet for \$2 (Heat Sheets will attempt to be made available 10 minutes prior to the start of the meet in the main atrium).</p>
PARKING:	<p>Free parking will be available in the parking lot on the east and south side of the high school. Parking lots labeled senior parking lots should be used. Signage will be available to instruct on where to park as other events will be taking place at the high school. Please use door #14 (Athletic Entrance) to enter.</p>
FACILITY NOTE:	<p>Franklin Community High School is a tobacco free facility.</p> <p>The Franklin High School Aquatic Center is one of the most beautiful high school facilities in the USA. It is important that all people attending this meet, whether it is swimmers, coaches, or spectators, treat this facility with the utmost care. The following rules will be strictly enforced:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Keep all trash picked up (swimmers and teams in particular). 2. Do not go, or let children go, in any unauthorized areas. Please keep children supervised at all times. 3. Due to USA Swimming insurance requirements, ONLY swimmers, coaches, officials, and volunteers are allowed on deck. There can be no exceptions! 4. No radios, balls, or anything that will be an inconvenience to swimmers, coaches, officials, workers, will be allowed. <p>The Franklin Regional Swim Team will have volunteers roaming the deck and locker room areas. If any swimmer is caught abusing the building or facility, they will immediately be asked to leave the meet and will be barred from further competition.</p>
MEDICAL:	<p>There will be lifeguards on duty throughout the course of the meet with access to first aid supplies and an AED.</p>
RULES:	<p>Current USA Swimming and Indiana Swimming rules, including MAAPT 2.0, will govern this meet.</p> <p>At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee shall assist the athlete in making</p>

arrangements for such supervision, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.

Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Coaches and Officials **MUST** display their current USA Swimming coach credential or Deck Pass to gain deck access. The meet referee and/or meet director reserves the right to ask for the coach's credentials or Deck Pass and/or deny deck access if a coach or official does not comply or a card is no longer valid/current.

In swimming competitions, the competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces except as provided in USA Swimming rule 205.10.1. All swimsuits shall be made from textile materials. For men, the swimsuit shall not extend above the navel nor below the knees, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms

Deck changes are prohibited.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas, and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice-Chair.

SAFE SPORT 360:

The Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy prohibits Applicable Adults (as defined) from having one-on-one interactions with minor athletes which are not within an observable and interruptible distance from another adult. Applicable Adults are required to abide by this policy in full during this meet.

Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. A report to the U.S. Center for SafeSport may be made via telephone at 720-531-0340 or online at www.uscenterforsafesport.org/report-a-concern. Various state laws may also require reporting to law enforcement or to a designated child protection agency.

All athletes age 18 and older must complete Athlete Protection Training in order to be a USA Swimming registered member in good standing. Any athlete who turns 18 on or after **May 21st, 2024**, who has not completed Athlete Protection Training by the first day of competition, will be prohibited from participating in the competition until such time as all membership requirements are completed. Times achieved by an athlete who turns age 18 on or after **June 21st, 2024**, who competes in this USA Swimming sanctioned event without completing this membership requirement, will NOT count for qualification or recognition. This includes participation as a member of a relay.

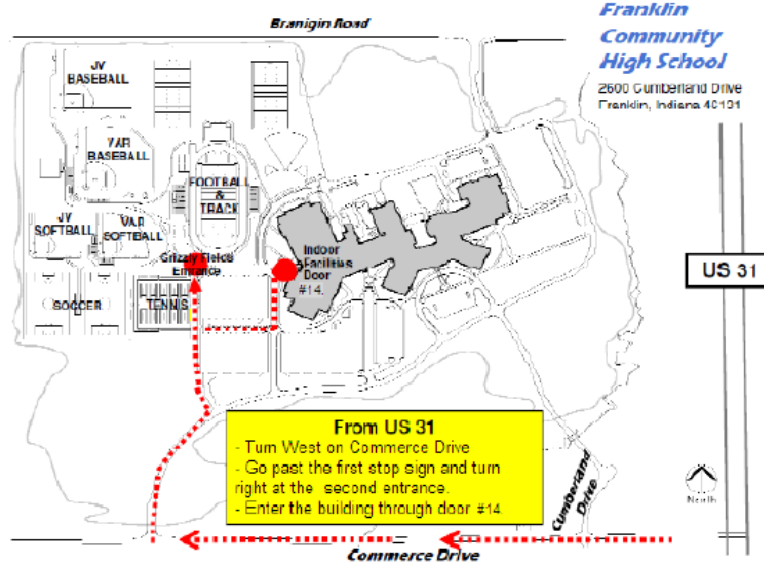

I-65 from the North

Exit I-65 at the Whiteland exit (exit 95) and head west to US 31 South. Go south on US 31 until you reach Commerce Drive. There is a stoplight at Commerce Drive (There is an Aaron's Rental and a Kentucky Fried Chicken on the corners), Head west on Commerce Drive. The high school is just ahead on the north side of the road. Take the second entrance into the school and proceed north into the athletic parking lot. Enter the building through Door #14.

I-65 from the South
