Other Information

- **ASL Fall SR/JR Circuit** has a fun format! Friday will be knockout 50 FRs! We will wittle the field down in rounds until we have 2 competitors left in a head-to-head final! The winner of each age group category will get a championship wrestling belt to take home with them. Sunday will be a timed finals (one swim in each event only).

Saturday will be a Prelims/Finals format for all age groups. It is the team expectation that if your athlete makes a finals swim they will be back at night to race. We are running a one-day prelims/finals meet for the benefit of our athletes. Historically, ASL does much better at night than other teams because of our experience racing Finals sessions. In November we are starting with a one day P/F session so that our athletes can experience it. In December we have our first set of championship meets, which will be two-day prelim/finals sessions. That builds off of our initial experience in November. Then, agian, in February and March we will have our second round of Championship meets which is where we shine as a group! By this time, our athletes are used to how these championship meets run and have learned what it feels like to race multiple sessions in a day. They are ready to rock and roll because of their prior racing experience. Racing experience is beneficial for any age because there are championship meets at every level. From Divisionals to Age Group and High School State, through College and beyond, every level utilizes the Prelim/Finals format.

- Practices During High School Meets
