Practice Schedules and Deadlines

Changes to the **NORMAL** Practice Schedule:

- Looks like a normal Monday-Friday for us, but we will ONLY have Senior Red/White and Junior Red on Saturday morning in Augusta, before the <u>Team Party</u> in Aiken. There will be NO Sunday practice this week for those athletes.
- ASL Team Party!!! We are super excited for this event, it was an amazing time last year and we're working hard to make sure it's even better this year.

Upcoming Deadlines:

- 'Second Call' for the November meets- our ASL Fall Invite on Nov 3-5, the RAYS IMX Meet on Nov 10-12, and for Sr White/Red, the SwimMAC LC/SC Invite on Nov 11-12. I'll have a list of folks qualified for the SwimMAC meet by Wednesday. It will likely be athletes with Senior Sectional level cuts.
- The November meets are a great opportunity for athletes to prepare themselves for 'back-to-back' Championship meets that spring up on the calendar, specifically in the summer- AG States & Zones, SR States & Futures, etc. Performing well over 2 meets and a 10-12 day period is a LEARNED skill. Those who practice it will master it.

Other Programming Notes:

- Please remember to send your athletes to the pool with a water bottle, and remind them that they should have it with them at their lane, and make use of it regularly throughout the practice. Many don't realize that they are sweating in the water, and once they get dehydrated, it won't get fixed until well after the training ends, and they'll struggle for the remainder of that session.

NEW Athletes to the Atlanta Bound Report (Fall Flash and Round 1 of Winter League)

The Georgia Swimming 14-Under Championships are held every February- it's the fastest Age Group Meet in Georgia!!! There are two parts to the meet. The first is the 11-14 State Meet portion, which is held over 3 days, with Prelims in the morning and Finals (top 20 11-12s, and top 30 13-14s from the preliminaries) at night. The second part is the 10-U State Meet along with the 11-14 B-Meet. This is held as a Timed Finals meet in between the 11-14 State Meet prelims and finals sessions.

The full report can also be found on the <u>Event Page</u> on our Website, and will be updated after every meet we attend. This report shows us who's headed to Atlanta in February (dark green for 11-14 State qualifiers, and light green for 10-U State and 11-14 B-Meet qualifiers, and everyone who's within a Wild Card shot of the cuts in yellow). We run this report so that as the season progresses, and athletes improve, you know when to think about doing some travel meets to take a run at qualifying for this event. If your athlete is in green, they're qualified and headed to Atlanta! If they're in yellow, they should find as many racing opportunities as they can on our schedule to take some shots at making cuts.

At these ages, 2, 3, 4 or even 10 (depending on how long it's been since they last raced the event) seconds in a 100y race is not insurmountable. In the last few seasons, we've had athletes drop from the Wildcard level twice with less than a month to qualify, from the Long Shot level over 10x, and countless drops from the Close and Within Reach levels... And we've still got 4 months of racing to go!!!

This is shaping up to be our biggest roster ever sent to this meet, and we couldn't be more excited about this awesome group of athletes. This is a list of athletes who moved up to a new level in this report over the last two weekends of racing- we've got FIVE new athletes who are ATLANTA BOUND in February (in bold)!!!
