



CARPET CAPITAL AQUATICS CLUB PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO POLICIES

1. The publishing of a photograph or video of swimmer under 18 either on a notice board or in a published article or video recording (including video streaming) of swimming competitions (“publication”) will only be done with parents’ consent per the attached form.
2. A parent or guardian has a right of refuse to have children photographed or videoed. The exercise of this right of refusal cannot be used as grounds for refusing entry into a swimming competition. Therefore any photo or video that may go to press or on a notice board, be it through a member of the club or official photographer, should receive parental consent before publishing/displaying the photo, preferably in writing. A form allowing parents to indicate refusal of consent is to follow.

In the case of open meets and other competitions where the host club has an official photographer present, all parents attending will be made aware of this in your meet information. If photos or videos are to be published anywhere, the individual parent will be given the opportunity to withhold their consent.

All photographs or videos will observe generally accepted standards of decency in particular:

- Action shots will be a celebration of the sporting activity and not a sexualized image in a sporting context.
- Action shots will not be taken or retained where the photograph reveals a torn or displaced swim suit.
- Photographs or videos will not be taken from behind swimming blocks at the start of a race or exhibit a child climbing out of the swimming pool.
- Photographs will not be taken in locker-rooms or bathrooms.
