Swimmers and Parents are to sign this document with registration package:

Athletes, parents and coaches must have a basic understanding of acceptable cooperative behavior in order to work as a cohesive unit and for all parties involved to have a positive experience.

Please follow these guidelines and remember to treat everyone with the respect you would like to be treated with yourself.

For Swimmers

- I will respect my teammates, competitors, coaches, parents, lifeguards, officials, and facility property.
- o I will behave in such a manner that will reflect positively on my team.
- I will play fair and always display good sportsmanship, in or out of the pool.
- I will be punctual for all practices and meets and will endeavor to have all the clothing and equipment needed for such.
- When in competition, I will wear my team uniform and conduct myself with dignity.
- I will not use offensive language or gestures, push or shove anyone into the water, disrespect anyone, interfere with another swimmer's movements in the water, or intentionally slow a swimmer's progress.

Failure to abide by our Code of Conduct as set forth here can result in the following disciplinary actions at the discretion of the coach and/or executive committee as they see fit according to the severity and/or frequency of the violation.

- 1. Time out.
- 2. Suspension from practice or meet.
- 3. Dismissal from the swim club for a period, for the season or for life.

For Parents

- o In addition to the above, I will not go on deck unless requested by a coach.
- o I will not talk about the coaching staff, pool staff, officials, athletes or other parents in a disrespectful or detrimental manner in the presences of the swimmers or other children.
- o I will leave the coaching to the coaching staff and abide by their disciplinary actions.
- o If I have issues with the coach or others, I will speak about it calmly at a time that will not disrupt or interrupt the practice or competition.

- o I will always be positive and encouraging to my child and all swimmers.
